

A Sickening Sermon: The Vision of a Ram, a Goat, and a Little Horn Daniel 8

- I. God reveals the suffering caused by the great and powerful. Many kings would come to trample.
 - A. He reveals political upheaval (8:1-8, 20-22). The ram and goat will trample the nations.
 - B. He reveals religious persecution (8:9-19, 23-26). The little horn will trample religion.
- II. God reveals the reversal of the great and powerful. Many kings would meet their end.
 - A. God breaks the power of the great (8:7, 8, 22, 25). The horn of each king was broken.
 - B. God restores right worship (8:13-14). The sanctuary would be restored to its rightful state
