I. Danger and enmity will be no more (11:6).

- a. Creation before and after the fall (Gen. 1:29-30; 3:24)
- b. Evil cosmic forces (Ps. 3:7; 22:13, 16, 20-21; 59; 91:13; Dan. 7; Rev. 12-13)
- c. Cosmic conflict with God (Gen. 3:24; Amos 1:2; 4:1; 5:18-20; Mt. 10:34)
- d. Man out of place (Gen. 1:28; Ps. 8; Ro. 8:23; Heb. 2:5-10)
- e. Salvation in Christ alone (Ro. 8:29-30; Eph. 2:13-14; Col. 1:15-23; Heb. 2:5-10; Rev. 5:5-6).
- f. Application

II. The creation will be renewed (11:7)

- a. Grace does not destroy, but renews. (Gal. 3:23-29)
- b. We shall be changed (1 Cor. 15:42-57; 2 Cor. 4:13-5:10)
- c. Application (1 Cor. 15:58; 15:12; 2 Cor. 5:11; Ro. 15:7; Gal. 3:23-29; 1 Cor. 15:42; 2 Cor. 5:4-5)

III. The curse on creation will end (11:8-9)

- a. The curse of death (Gen. 3:24)
- b. Our enemy Satan (Gen. 3)
- c. The curse of the Law (Gal. 3:10; Col. 2:14)
- d. The end of the curse (1 Cor. 15:54-57; Rev. 20; Ro. 5:1; Gal. 3:13)
- e. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Hab. 2:14; Amos 5:18ff; Jn. 1:16-18; 3:14)
