1. May this Word of God impress upon us, as parents, the high calling we have to train our children.
2. This Word of God is also an encouragement to this morning – when he is old...

The Meaning

1. We have in the text a command, “Train up a child in the way that he should go”
2. We must see our children in a right, Biblical way.
3. The Word of God calls parents to train, mold and shape their children with a focus on the heart.

The Manner

1. God calls us to train using the Word of God.
2. This training must be done with consistency until they are adults.
3. You must train your children with the affection and love in God.
