*Love cooled and rekindled*

I. The \_\_\_\_\_ : her foolish \_\_\_\_\_ : v2-3

*Taking one another for granted*

*(she pictured as the guilty one because he is a picture of Christ)*

*Beware things creeping in between you and your spouse:*

*(Gen 2:24 cf. Job 41:17)*

*or between you and your Lord:*

II. The \_\_\_\_\_ : his wise \_\_\_\_\_ : v4-6a

A. He does **not** retaliate

*Blow up*

*Clam up*

B. He **does** communicate love in a way she can receive

C. He *gives her space*

*Does not the Lord do this to you?*

III. The \_\_\_\_\_ : her love is \_\_\_\_\_ : v4b – 6:3

A. She no longer takes him for granted

*She wants him back*

B. Life goes hard for her

C. What is so great about him? (v9)

*Her greatest praise for him in the entire book*

1. *Admiration*

2. *Affection*

D. Where will you ever find him again?

*He is faithful and can always be found*

*6:3 ends with a reaffirmation of the covenant, only with the focus more on him, cf. to 2:16*

So what

1. Are you husbands & wives taking each other for granted?

*What if your spouse left?*

2. Need for periodic renewal: plan some time away together

*Marriage Conference Nov 7-9*

3. What about your love for Jesus? Do you take Him for granted?

*Are you eager to meet with Him each day? Has your love grown cold?*

*The Church needs this same experience with Jesus.*

*Be amazed again at the riches of His grace in response to your sin!*

*Rev 3:14-22.*

*It is called Revival.*
