I. What does it mean to have a heart like God?

- a. The Definition – 1 Samuel 13:14, Acts 13:22
 - i. “Heart” – the inner being, mind & will
 - ii. “After” – inclinations, likes, dislikes
 - iii. Obedience to God & His will – Phil. 2:5-11
- b. The Decision – Romans 12:1-2
 - i. The Choices – God or Satan – 1 Sam. 16:14, Exodus 32:26, Joshua 24:14-15, Matthew 6:24, John 10:10
 - ii. The Evidence – Romans 6:15-18, Acts 13:22

II. David the servant – 1 Sam. 16:18

- a. His Craft – God used his skill
- b. His Character – Joshua 1:6-9
 - i. Brave – courage
 - ii. Warrior – strong, skilled – 1 Sam. 14:52
- c. His Charisma
 - i. Speaks well = intelligent, wise, discerning
 - ii. Fine looking – kept himself well
- d. His Confidence – 1 Sam. 16:14, 18:8-12; Philippians 4:13
