- B. The <u>reason</u> for submission given (v. 23)
 - 1. as Christ is head headship granted at creation
 - 2. as He is the Savior of the body
 - 3. it is a God-given delegated authority
 - 4. it pictures the union of all things under Christ
- C. The scope of the wife's submission
 - 1. her own husband
 - 2. in everything
 - 3. are there cases where a wife should not submit?
 - 4. Is she to submit to an unbelieving husband?
 - a. 1 Peter 2:13,18, 3:1-6
 - 5. the "Yeah, but" attitude
- D. The manner of the wife's submission as to the Lord
 - 1. How does the church submit to Christ?
