The BIG Question
Do you believe that God is totally, fully, completely, and entirely committed to the of His people even when He seems silent, and distant, and inactive?
The BIG Temptation
When God seems silent and distant and inactive, we are going to be tempted to believe that God has us, and forsaken us, and us.
Hebrews 13:5, "I will never leave you or forsake you."
2 Corinthians 6:18, "I will be a father to you, and you shall be sons and daughters to me," says the Lord Almighty."
God is doing something in the midst of the ordinary (verses 1-5).
God's hand becoming visible
<ul> <li>"On night"</li> <li>A king sleep</li> <li>And asks for a to be read.</li> <li>The servant reads a story</li> <li>That highlights the king's failure to Mordecai.</li> <li>Meanwhile, arrives at the palace</li> </ul>
Zechariah 2:8, "For thus said the LORD of hosts $\dots$ 'He who touches you touches the apple of my eye."
Two Applications:
<ol> <li>God is always at work in the Ephesians 1:11, "He works all things according to the counsel of his will."</li> </ol>
2) God is always at work in the Psalm 31:15-17, "I trust in you, O LORD; I say, 'You are my God.' My times are in your hand; rescue me from the hand of my enemies and from my persecutors. Make your face shine on your servant, save me in your steadfast love."
God will His people by exposing those who oppose His people (verses 6-13).
