Sermon: "No Sympathy For The Devil." What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 5

I Text:

Old Covenant: Genesis 6:1-11; Judges 1:27-36

New Covenant: 2 Corinthians 6

II Doctrine:

The book of Judges continues to expose the inability of God's people to obey his commands. The lack of faith and courage leads to the Israelites allowing their enemies to live among them. God warned that failing to expel the Satanists from the land would cost Israel dearly.
