	Fasting was commanded in the Day of Atonement (Leviticus 16:29-33). People fasted in conjunction with prayer signifying and sorrow for sin (Judges 20:26; 1 Samuel 7; Nehemiah 1:4; 9:1; Jeremiah 36:6, 9; Daniel 9; Joel 1:14; 2:12, 15; Jonah 3:5). People fasted in conjunction with prayer to seek the Lord in times of great (2 Samuel 12:22; Psalm 35, 69, 109; 2 Samuel 1:12; 2 Chronicles 20:1). People fasted in conjunction with prayer to seek the Lord before attempting a new (Ezrah 8:21-23; Esther 4). People fasted as an outward ritual with no heart to seek the Lord (1 Kings 21:9-12; Isaiah
New ¹	58). Testament
•	Jesus fasted (Matthew 4). Jesus said that His would fast (Matthew 9:14-15). Jesus pairs fasting with prayer as a part of praying for God's intervention in " " (Matthew 17:21).
