The Conversion of Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9:1-19)

Conversion of Saul is among greatest events in history of the church

Of the 27 books of the NT Paul the apostle penned 14: just over 51% (Heb)

I. Saul of Tarsus Persecutor of the Church

First introduction to Saul at the stoning death of Stephen (7:58)

Saul approved of Stephen's death, was ravaging Christians (8:1,3)

Breathing out threats, letter from high priest to arrest more Christians (9:2)

II. Arrested by Christ

Saul overwhelmed, fell to the ground (9:3,4) why do you persecute me? (5) When he asked "Lord, who are you?" I am Jesus whom you are persecuting Paul's reflection "It pleased God to reveal His Son in Me (Galatians1:16) Saul was shaken, believed Jesus of Nazareth was alive, not dead & buried Voice accused Him of persecuting Jesus, he was persecuting Christians

III. Conquered Instantly by Grace

Saul was passive in the encounter: Christ had set him apart (Galatians 1:16)

Saul: rendered helpless –blinded, needed to help to Damascus (9:6)

IV. Soundly Converted

Saul of Tarsus persecutor of the church: baptized in the name of Jesus (9:18)
Saul was visited by Ananias & received as a brother cautiously (9:11,18)

V. Prayer

• This is the first time Saul is said to be praying (9:11) true faith = prayer
