- Three general areas of temptation

"Promised the World"

- A. The "Carrot" -- "all the kingdoms of this world"
 - The "View" from on top-- v. 5
 - Physically impossible
 - Must have been a vision
 - Satan use of the "imagination" of man
 - God created us with imaginative powers
 - Imagination can be used for either good or evil purposes
 - The "Offer"-- v. 6
 - a. Presents the positive-- the "power and splendor"
 b. Satan has the "right" to offer the kingdom
 The "Lure"-- why this "carrot" is appealing to Jesus
 - Jesus will one day inherit all of the nations-- Ps 2; Dan 7:13-14
 - But Jesus could have them NOW-- Instant gratification
 - Jesus could have them without the cross-- Painless Acquisition
 - Satan's interest in bypassing the Cross
 - The Cross seals Satan and his cohort's doom
 - The Cross frees Satan's captives.
- The "Cost"-- "Bow down and worship me"-- 4:7
 - Satan views this as a "Win-Win" situation
 - He receives the worship he has always craved-- Isa 14
 - Jesus gets his kingdoms now without pain
 - Real Cost: Renounce his allegiance to the Father
 - The "hidden" cost of sin
- The "Cure"-- How Jesus resisted the temptation.
 - "Get that out of my face"-- 4:8
 - Remove object of lust from before your eyes
 - Illustration -- David b.
 - "Casting down imaginations" -- 2 Corinthians 10:3-5
 - "Pledge allegiance to God and God alone"—Deut. 6:3
 - Be content
 - Willingness to wait
 - Make a covenant with our eyes—Job 31:1
