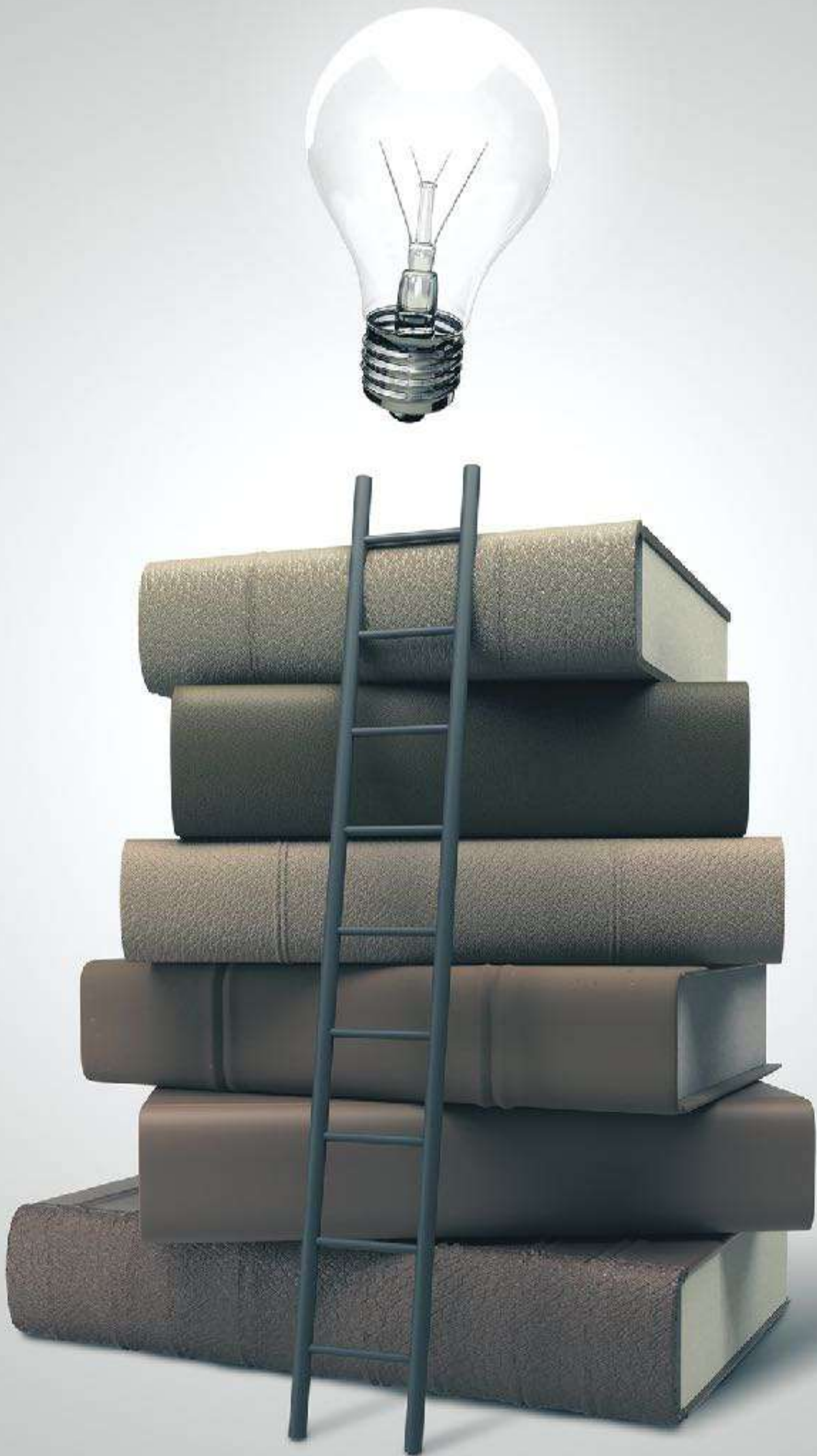
WHAT IS PROPITIATION?

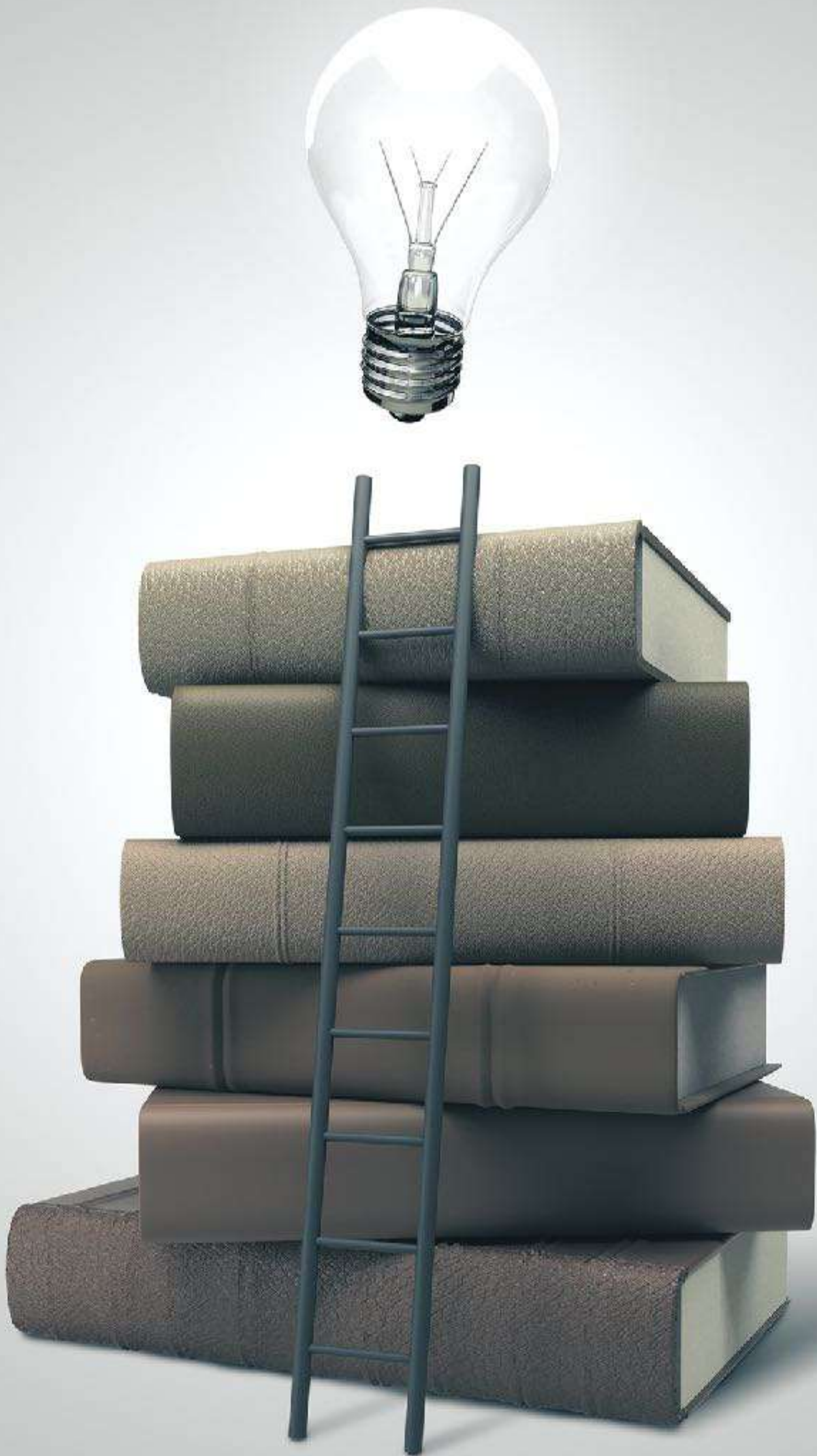

WHY IS PROPITIATION
NECESSARY?

The Theme of *Righteousness* at Play in the Text

1. 1:5 - God is light and therefore the definition of true righteousness
2. 1:6-7 - Walk in the light and behave righteously
3. 1:8-10 - Don't claim to be perfectly righteous; confess your sin



WHY IS PROPITIATION NECESSARY?

1. God's wrath against sinners is real
2. God's wrath against sinners is powerful
3. God's wrath against sinners is personal

- "All have sinned" (Romans 3:23)

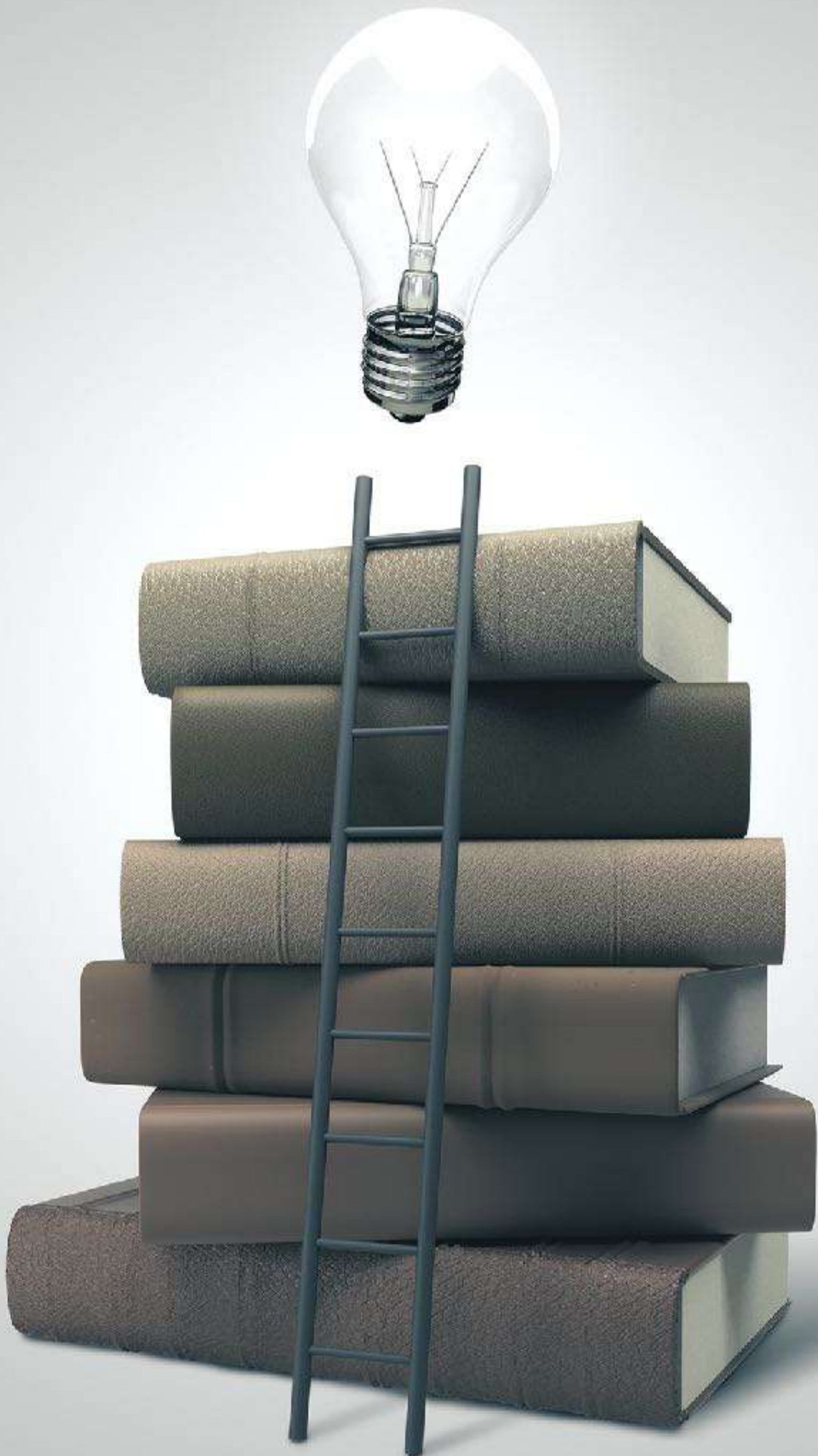

1. Christ's substitutionary death was universal in its provision (2 Peter 2:1; 1 Timothy 2:6; 4:10)
2. Christ's substitutionary death was limited in its application to those who believe (John 3:16; 6:37; 1 Timothy 4:10)
