SERMON: BOOKS ABOUT CHRIST: JEREMIAH

- I. The prophet Jeremiah
 - A. Son of Hilkiah, a priest
 - B. Prophesied for about 40 years (626-587 B.C.)
 - C. Five kings of Judah (Josiah, Jehoahaz Jehoiakim, Jehoiachin, Zedekiah)
 - D. A prophet to the nations (Jeremiah 1:5,10: 25:15ff.)
- II. Jeremiah's dual message, typical of the Old Testament prophets:
 - A. Judgment: upon Judah and the nations
 - B. Deliverance: through the Messiah, realized in days yet to come
- III. God's message through Jeremiah summarized in "days are coming"
 - A. Days are coming for judgment (7 references)
 - 1. Jeremiah 7:32 upon Judah, the valley of Slaughter
 - 2. Jeremiah 9:25 upon those circumcised but yet uncircumcised
 - 3. Jeremiah 19:6 Jerusalem will become a desolation
 - 4. Jeremiah 48:12 upon Moab
 - 5. Jeremiah 49:2 upon Ammon
 - 6. Jeremiah 51:47 upon Babylon
 - 7. Jeremiah 51:52 upon Babylon
 - B. Days are coming for deliverance (8 references)
 - 1. Jeremiah 16:14 they shall know My name is the LORD (verse 21)
 - 2. Jeremiah 23:5 a righteous Branch for David, called the LORD our righteousness
 - 3. Jeremiah 23:7 a deliverance surpassing the Exodus from Egypt
 - 4. Jeremiah 30:3 I will restore the fortunes of Israel and Judah
 - 5. Jeremiah 31:27 to build and to plant (see Jer. 1:10)
 - 6. Jeremiah 31:31 I will make a new covenant
 - 7. Jeremiah 31:38 the city will be rebuilt, once and for all
 - 8. Jeremiah 33:14 the capstone: for all of God's people, a righteous Branch of David will execute justice and righteousness on the earth, we will be called "the LORD is our righteousness", He is judge, priest king....a covenant and promise that can never be broken or shaken!
