### ***When I survey the wondrous cross***

**Luk 9:44** Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men.

**1Co 2:2** For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

**Gal 6:14** But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ...

**1Co 1:23** But we preach Christ crucified...

1Co 1:24 ...unto them which are called...Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

2Pe 1:9 But he that lacketh these things (*all things that pertain unto godliness*) is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

*And when I think of God, His Son not sparing, Sent Him to die, I scarce can take it in...*

*My sin – oh, the bliss of this glorious thought, My sin, not in part, but the whole...*

**On which the Prince of glory...**

Isa 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Heb 7:2 ...King of Salem, which is, King of peace;

Act 3:15 And killed the Prince of life, whom God hath raised from the dead...

Act 5:31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand *to be* a Prince and a Saviour...

Zec 3:1 And he shewed me Joshua the high priest...

Zec 3:3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

Zec 3:4 And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

Zec 3:5 And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.

Zec 6:11 Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set *them* upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest...

Zec 6:13 Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Eze 44:3 *It (the east gate) is* for the prince; the prince, he shall sit in it to eat bread before the LORD; he shall enter by the way of the porch of *that* gate, and shall go out by the way of the same.

Eze 45:17 And it shall be the prince's part *to give* burnt offerings...he shall prepare the sin offering...and the peace offerings, to make reconciliation for the house of Israel.

Eze 46:18 Moreover the prince shall not take of the people's inheritance by oppression, to thrust them out of their possession; *but* he shall give his sons inheritance out of his own possession: that my people be not scattered every man from his possession.

**Died**

Joh 10:17 ... lay down my life, that I might take it again.

Joh 10:18 No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again...

***See, from His head, His hands, His feet,***

Joh 19:5 Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And *Pilate* saith unto them, Behold the man!

Joh 20:25 ...Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.

Rev 1:7 Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

***Sorrow and love flow mingled down;***

Heb 12:2 Looking unto Jesus...who...endured the cross, despising the shame...

Isa 53:3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief...

Psa 22:6 But I *am* a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people.

Isa 50:6 ...I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

Mat 27:39 And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads,

Mat 27:46 ...My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

Joh 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

1Jn 3:16 Hereby perceive we the love *of God*, because he laid down his life for us...

***What wondrous love is this, O my soul, O my soul...***

***Did e'er such love and sorrow meet. Or thorns compose so rich a crown?***

Psa 85:10 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed *each other*.

Heb 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour...

Php 3:7 But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.

Php 3:8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things *but* loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them *but* dung, that I may win Christ,

**Php 3:13** Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but *this* one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,

**Php 3:14** I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

***Were the whole realm of nature mine, That were a present far too small,***

**Psa 50:9** I will take no bullock out of thy house, *nor* he goats out of thy folds.

**Psa 50:10** For every beast of the forest *is* mine, *and* the cattle upon a thousand hills.

**Mic 6:7** Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams...shall I give my firstborn *for* my transgression, the fruit of my body *for* the sin of my soul?

**Mic 6:8** He hath shewed thee, O man, what *is* good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

**Hos 6:6** For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings.

**Psa 51:16** For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give *it*: thou delightest not in burnt offering.

**Psa 51:17** The sacrifices of God *are* a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart...

**1Pe 2:5** Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

**Joh 4:23** But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

**Joh 4:24** God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

**Mat 9:12** But when Jesus heard *that*, he said unto them, They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick.

**Mat 9:13** But go ye and learn what *that* meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

***Love so amazing, so divine, Demands my soul, my life, my all.***

**2Co 5:14** For the love of Christ constraineth us...

**2Th 3:5** And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

**Eph 3:18** May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height;

**Eph 3:19** And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.

**Mar 12:30** And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment.

Mar 12:31 And the second *is* like, *namely* this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, *which is* your reasonable service.

Joh 21:17 ...Simon, *son* of Jonas, lovest thou me? ...Feed my sheep.

Act 9:6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? ...

Joh 20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

Tit 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Tit 2:14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar (*special due to possession*) people, zealous of good works.
