Created Means Under Sovereign Control 1 Chronicles 21-22:1 (350); 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:10 (967)

Our story today is a dark and mysterious one. After David's sin God required a *specific* action of David to avert his wrath (v 18), and the site of David's sacrifice will become the most holy sanctuary of the First Temple (22:1). Today we delve into the spiritual (demonic) world with the introduction of "The Adversary" (i.e. Satan). God does not tempt anyone (Ja. 1:13) but establishes his good purpose in this terrible event.
