and that which they have laid up,



I. THE JUDGMENT UPON ASSYRIA (14:24-27)



A. The Purpose of God Shall Stand

**ISAIAH 14:24,
The Lord of hosts hath sworn, saying,
Surely as I have thought,
so shall it come to pass;
And as I have purposed,
so shall it stand:**

B. The Power of God Shall be Seen

**ISAIAH 14:25,
That I will break the Assyrian in my land,
And upon my mountains tread him under foot:
Then shall his yoke depart from off them,
And his burden depart from off their shoulders.**

C. The Point of God's Sovereignty Shall be Stretched Internationally

ISAIAH 14:26,

**This is the purpose that is purposed upon the whole earth:
And this is the hand that is stretched out upon all the nations.**

D. The Plan of God Shall be Seen Unstoppable

**ISAIAH 14:27,
For the Lord of hosts hath purposed,
and who shall disannul it?
And his hand is stretched out,
and who shall turn it back?**

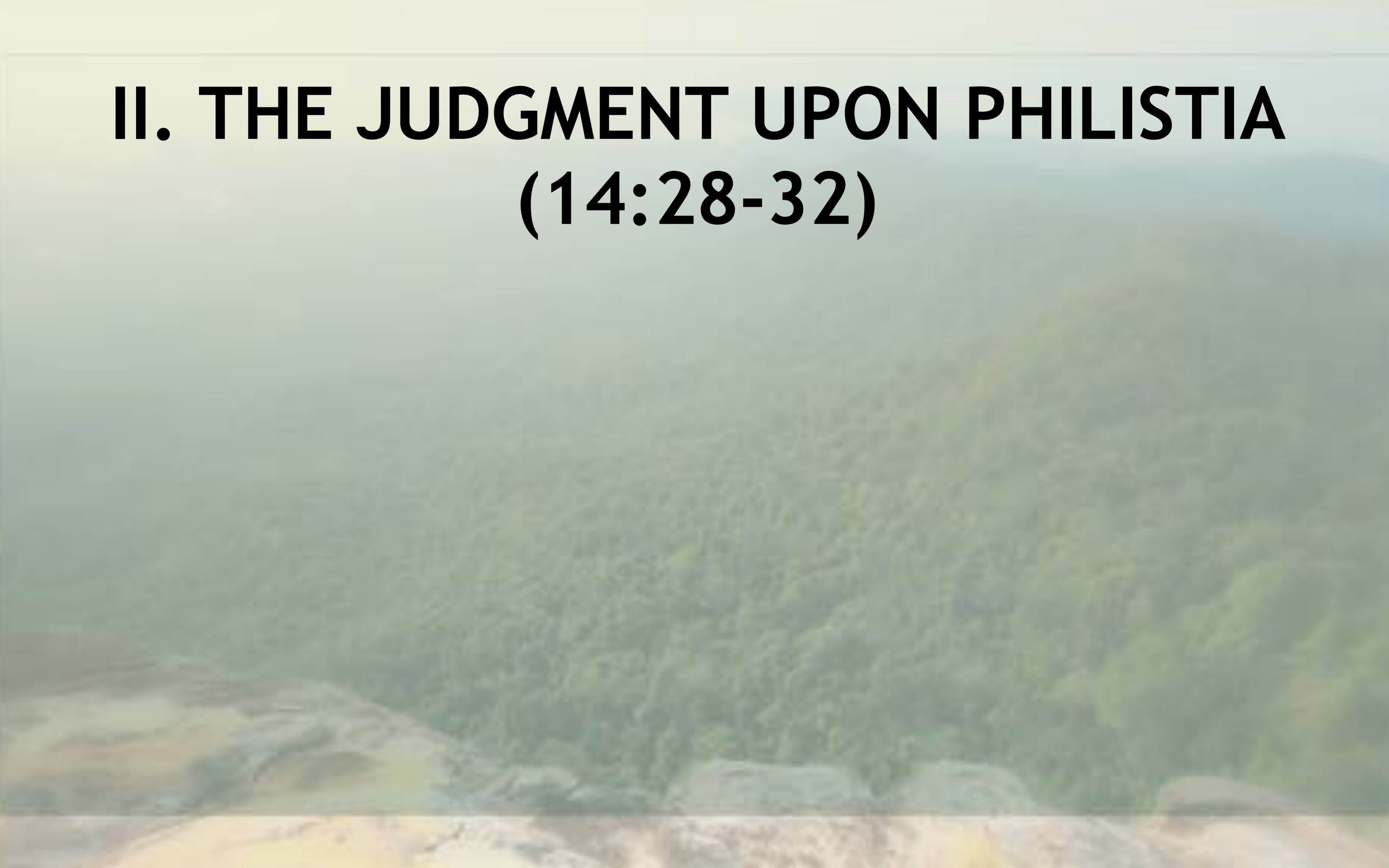
THE APPLICATIONS FOR YOU

II. THE JUDGMENT UPON PHILISTIA

(14:28-32)



A. The Context: the Death of Ahaz

ISAIAH 14:28,

In the year that king Ahaz died was this burden.

B. The Caution - Do not Gloat

ISAIAH 14:29,

Rejoice not thou, whole Palestina,

Because the rod of him that smote thee is broken:

For out of the serpent's root shall come forth a cockatrice,

And his fruit shall be a fiery flying serpent.

C. The Catastrophic Judgment

ISAIAH 14:30,

**And the firstborn of the poor shall feed,
And the needy shall lie down in safety:**

**And I will kill thy root with famine,
And he shall slay thy remnant.**

D. The Commands to Howl and Cry

**ISAIAH 14:31,
Howl, O gate;
cry, O city;**

**Thou, whole Palestina, art dissolved:
For there shall come from the north a smoke,
And none shall be alone in his appointed times.**

E. The Central Point: Trust in Yahweh

ISAIAH 14:32,

**What shall one then answer the messengers of the nation?
That the Lord hath founded Zion,
And the poor of his people shall trust in it.**

III. The Judgment of Moab (15:1-9)



A. Moab will be Decimated

ISAIAH 15:1,

The burden of Moab.

**Because in the night Ar of Moab is laid waste,
and brought to silence;**

**Because in the night Kir of Moab is laid waste,
and brought to silence;**

B. Moab will be Demoralized

ISAIAH 15:2,

He is gone up to Bajith,

and to Dibon, the high places, to weep:

Moab shall howl over Nebo, and over Medeba:

On all their heads shall be baldness, and every beard cut off.

C. Moab will be Deeply Discouraged and Depressed

ISAIAH 15:3,

**In their streets they shall gird themselves with sackcloth:
On the tops of their houses, and in their streets,
Every one shall howl, weeping abundantly.**

D. Moab will be Defeated

ISAIAH 15:4,

And Heshbon shall cry, and Elealeh:

Their voice shall be heard even unto Jahaz:

Therefore the armed soldiers of Moab shall cry out;

His life shall be grievous unto him.

E. Moab will be Desperate

ISAIAH 15:5,

My heart shall cry out for Moab;

His fugitives shall flee unto Zoar,

An heifer of three years old:

For by the mounting up of Luhith

with weeping shall they go it up;

For in the way of Horonaim

they shall raise up a cry of destruction.

F. Moab will be Desolate

ISAIAH 15:6,

For the waters of Nimrim shall be desolate:

**For the hay is withered away, the grass faileth,
there is no green thing.**

G. Moab will be Displaced, Deported

ISAIAH 15:7,

**Therefore the abundance they have gotten,
and that which they have laid up,
Shall they carry away to the brook of the willows.**

H. Moab will be Distressed

**ISAIAH 15:8,
For the cry is gone round about the borders of Moab;
The howling thereof unto Eglaim,
and the howling thereof unto Beer-elim.**

I. Moab will be Detected

ISAIAH 15:9,

**For the waters of Dimon shall be full of blood:
For I will bring more upon Dimon,
Lions upon him that escapeth of Moab,
And upon the remnant of the land.**

- 5. Look for ways to come alongside broken people.**
