

Definition:	Regulative Principle of Worship: "What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it." (Deut. 12:32)			
	Regulative Principle of Worship: "the acceptable way of worshiping the true God is instituted by himself, and so limited by his own revealed will, that he may not be worshiped according to the imaginations and devices of men, or the suggestions of Satan, under any visible representation, or any other way not prescribed in the Holy Scripture."			
Definition:	Element/Ordinance of Worship: a duty of a religious nature, commanded by God for approaching Him in Divine Worship, with attached manners/ways for it to be engaged in according to His divine institution.			
Definition:	Circumstance of Worship: "there are some circumstances concerning the worship of God, and government of the Church, common to human actions and societies, which are to be ordered by the light of nature and Christian prudence, according to the general rules of the Word, which are always to be observed." (see 1 Cor 11:13-14; 14:26, 40)			
	Circumstance of Worship: common actions, without any religious or sacred nature at any time, but pertaining to order and decorum, which is necessary for obeying God's ordinances of worship.
