Sermon: God's law is not against the promise of God, but serves the interests of the Gospel.

1. God's law is not against the promises of God? (v. 21).
 - A. The law could not bring life otherwise righteousness would have been given by the law (v. 21).
 - B. The law confines all under sin from among which believers would look to the promise (v. 22).
2. God's law serves the interests of the Gospel (v. 23-25), kept us under guard till faith was revealed (v. 23).
 - A. The law kept us under guard till faith (Christ) was revealed (v. 23).
 - B. The law was the tutor of faith whereas Christ was the embodiment of faith (v. 24).
 - C. The law is no longer needed as a tutor, because we now have the Holy Spirit who has written the law in our hearts (v. 25, cp. Heb. 10:16).

**WESTMINSTER CONFESSION OF FAITH
Chapter 7, Of God's Covenant with Man**

4. This covenant of grace is frequently set forth in the Scripture by the name of a Testament, in reference to the death of Jesus Christ the testator, and to the everlasting inheritance, with all things belonging to it, therein bequeathed.(1) (1) Heb. 9:15,16,17; Heb. 7:22; Luke 22:20; 1 Cor. 11:25.
5. This covenant was differently administered in the time of the law, and in the time of the gospel;(1) under the law it was administered by promises, prophecies, sacrifices, circumcision, the paschal lamb, and other types and ordinances delivered to the people of the Jews, all foreshadowing Christ to come,(2) which were for that time sufficient and efficacious, through the operation of the Spirit, to instruct and build up the elect in faith in the promised Messiah,(3) by whom they had full remission of sins, and eternal salvation; and is called the Old Testament.(4) (1) 2 Cor. 3:6,7,8,9; (2) Heb. 8,9 & 10; Rom. 4:11; Col. 2:11,12; 1 Cor. 5:7; (3) 1 Cor. 10:1,2,3,4; Heb. 11:13; John 8:56; (4) Gal. 3:7,8,9,14.
6. Under the gospel, when Christ the substance(1) was exhibited, the ordinances in which this covenant is dispensed are the preaching of the Word, and the administration of the sacraments of Baptism and the Lord's Supper,(2) which, though fewer in number, and administered with more simplicity and less outward glory, yet in them it is held forth in more fulness, evidence, and spiritual efficacy,(3) to all nations, both Jews and Gentiles;(4) and is called the New Testament.(5) There are not therefore two covenants of grace differing in substance, but one and the same under various dispensations.(6) (1) Col. 2:17; (2) Matt. 28:19,20; 1 Cor. 11:23,24,25; (3) Heb. 12:22-27; Jer. 31:33,34; (4) Matt. 28:19; Eph. 2:15-19; (5) Luke 22:20; (6) Gal. 3:14,16; Acts 15:11; Rom. 3:21,22,23,30; Ps. 32:1; Rom. 4:3,6,16,17,23,24; Heb. 13:8.

LORD'S SUPPER NEXT SUNDAY

Lord willing we will again have the joy of celebrating the Lord's Supper next Sunday. 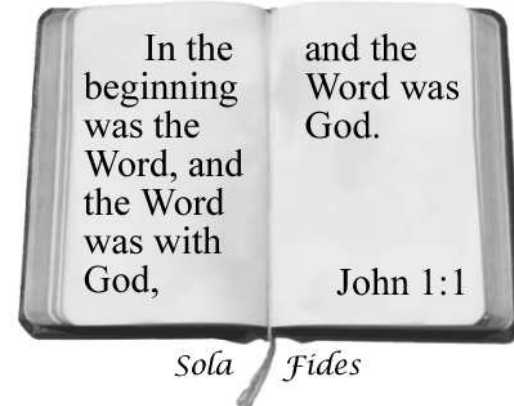
