INTRODUCTION

- 1. Both AM & PM: shine light on Xns & "condemnation" by men, but not God
- 2. Rm 8:33,34a words arranged for emphasis: contrast the 2 who & 2 God's.

 v31b contrast tw/ God and who. Legal: God is for us who is against us?

1st: God Has Elected Us in Christ

- 1. *God's elect:* synecdoche <u>v29-30</u>. Why emphasize *election? God's elect* epitomizes pre-conversion blessings. *Justification* [v33b-34a] epitomizes post-conversion blessings.
- 2. We cannot isolate 1 saving blessing from all blessings. To possess any saving blessing is to possess all saving blessings cited in v29-30. Do not isolate election [1Pt 1:10 *chosen*] 2Ptr 1:10 [context of v5-9]. Is it obvious that we are trusting & following Christ? Why? Election.

2nd: God Has Justified Us in Christ

- 1. Rm 8:33-34a We are not justified in eternity past by virtue of election. Jesus must accomplish our salvation in history & we believe in history & justification is given to faith, then legal status is changed in Christ.
- 2. God is the focus God elects; God justifies. LBC 11:1
- **3.** Opposite of *justification* = *condemn*. God will not tolerate a charge against His elect in His court b/c the elect are recipients of His grace in Christ: 4:25
- 4. We are legally loved.
