### I. The Transfiguration Revealed the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Son Of God

#### A. The Description of What Happened to Jesus in Luke

- 1) The literal meaning of verse 29: “what you could see of His face or front became \_\_\_\_\_”
- 2) Jesus’ clothing could not contain the light of His presence: His clothing flashed like \_\_\_\_\_

#### B. The Description of What Happened to Jesus in Matthew and Mark

- 1) Both use the word \_\_\_\_\_ which in the original language gives us our English *metamorphosis*
- 2) Like a butterfly from a cocoon, Jesus’ \_\_\_\_\_ changed to reflect what He truly was within

### II. The Transfiguration Revealed that Jesus Was \_\_\_\_\_ than the Law and the Prophets

#### A. Why Were Moses and Elijah Present with Jesus at His Transfiguration?

- 1) Some suggest that they represent the 2 groups who will be present when Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ in glory
- 2) More importantly, they represent the whole of the \_\_\_\_\_ revelation and dispensation

#### B. The Father’s response indicates it is only through \_\_\_\_\_ teaching that we can understand the OT

### III. The Transfiguration Revealed All Over Again the Kind of \_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus Had Come to Be

#### A. The Three Disciples \_\_\_\_\_ through Most of the Discussion between Jesus and Moses and Elijah

#### B. When They Did Awake, Peter Suggested that They Should Celebrate the Feast of \_\_\_\_\_

- 1) The Feast of Tabernacles commemorated God’s provision for Israel in the \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) But according to Zech. 14, it will also be celebrated when Messiah returns to set up His \_\_\_\_\_
  - a) Jesus had been glorified (!) so Peter wanted to set up the \_\_\_\_\_ right then and there
  - b) But the Father directed the disciples to listen to Jesus whose teaching was focused on the \_\_\_\_\_
  - c) One of the lessons of the transfiguration: glory always and only follows the cross—for \_\_\_\_\_

### IV. The Transfiguration Revealed the Meaning of the \_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus Had Predicted He Would Die

#### A. “Accomplish” is consistently translated \_\_\_\_\_ throughout the NT and a better translation here Jesus didn’t die like every other human being: Jesus’ death was something that He fulfilled in 2 ways:

- 1) Jesus’ death was the fulfillment of dozens of OT \_\_\_\_\_
- 2) Jesus’ death was the fulfillment of God’s plan of \_\_\_\_\_

#### B. “Decease” in the original language is the word \_\_\_\_\_; its use is significant since Moses was present

- 1) This word refers not just to Jesus’ death but also to His \_\_\_\_\_ and ascension to heaven
- 2) What are the parallels between the Exodus and what Jesus Christ accomplished for us?
  - a) Israel’s bondage in Egypt is a picture of bondage to \_\_\_\_\_; that is what Jesus came to deal with
  - b) God called a \_\_\_\_\_; for Israel it was Moses; for us it was His only begotten Son
  - c) God displayed His supernatural power to deliver Israel—the 10 \_\_\_\_\_  
God displayed His supernatural power to deliver us—the \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus
  - d) The Passover—the blood applied to the doorposts points to Jesus’ blood shed on the \_\_\_\_\_
