

Two Things that are *NOT* the case in Isaiah 9:6

- ❖ This is *NOT* a reference to the first person of the Trinity
- ❖ This is *NOT* a denial of the Trinitarian doctrine

If you will correctly unlock the meaning of the name “Everlasting Father” it will completely change your perspective on Jesus.



How is He a Father to us?

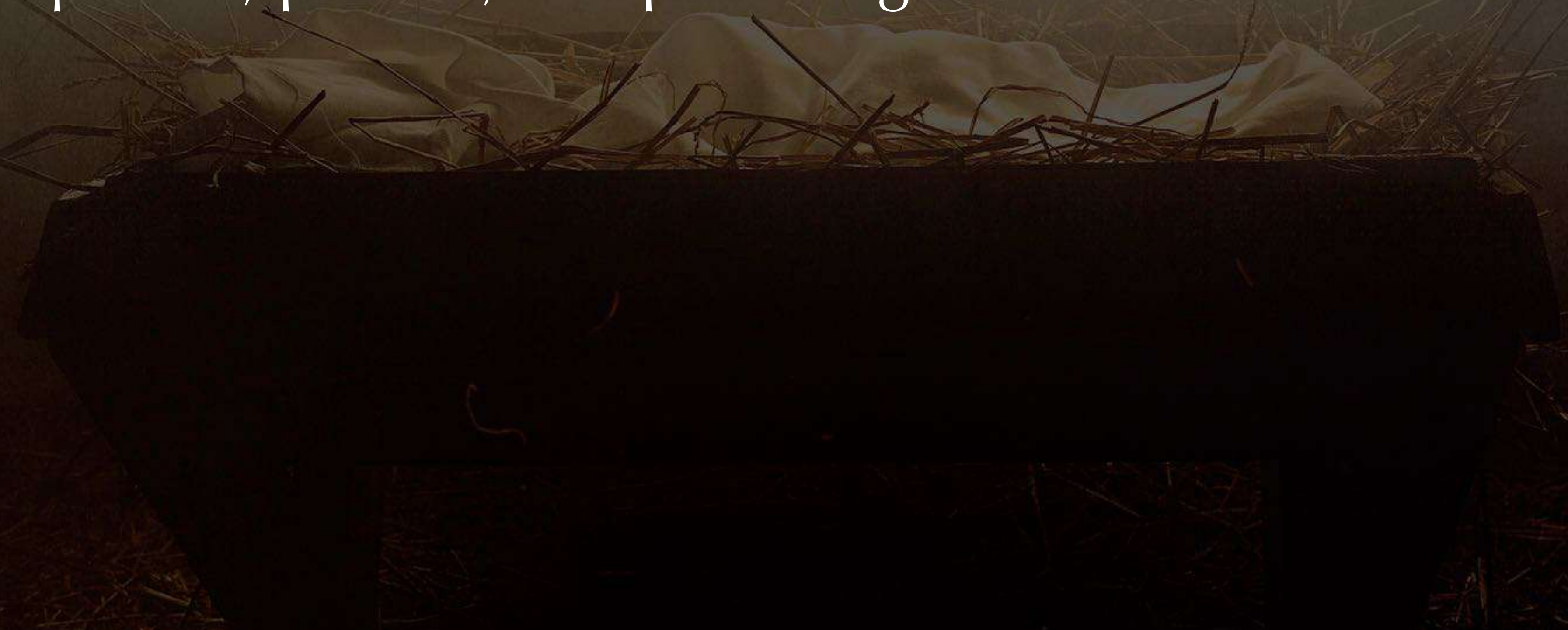
1. He is a father in His creation of us
2. He is a father in His compassion for us


Wrong Views About God as a Father Many People Unfortunately Have


#3: Jesus Has a Powerful Relationship with Us - *“Father of the Ages to Come”*


