## **Discussion Questions**

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others.

- 1. What stood out to you in the sermon? Why?
- 2. What is Satan trying to do in God's church when he uses infiltration and imitation?
- 3. In what way are the women referred to in verse 6 "weak"?
- 4. What does it mean in verse 9 that "they will not get very far"?
- 5. Describe Paul's "aim in life" (verse 10).
- 6. Describe Paul's love for others (verse 10).
- 7. What does Paul saying the Lord rescued him from all his persecutions mean (verse 11)?

## Going Deeper:

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

- 1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking, or grow your understanding?
- 2. Why do those who feel the most guilty often come under the power of domineering, opinionated leaders? Why are those at rest in God's grace, less likely to do so?
- 3. How do verses 8-9 help us at our jobs, schools, neighborhoods and family gatherings when people oppose our witness for Christ?
- 4. For each item in Paul's list in verses 10-11, think of someone you know who embodies that item. What are you learning from those people?
- 5. Which one of the items in verses 10-11 do you think people are most likely to see in you?
- 6. What is the primary way you should be affected by this passage this week?
