Holiness Defined

- The root meaning of the Hebrew noun and adjective means to *cut* or to *separate*
- Holiness is not primarily a reference to moral or ethical purity. It is a reference to *transcendence*

Holiness Declared

- In His Name
- In His Presence
- In His People

Holiness Declared

- God's holiness is seen in *His people*; they *reflect* His character in their lives
- Apart from God's righteousness *no one* can enter God's presence
