Acts 25, 26, Paul before the judgment seat of Festus & King Agrippa

1. Paul is brought before Festus in Caesarea (25:1-12)
2. Paul is brought before King Agrippa II (25:13-25)
3. Festus and Agrippa weighed in the scales (26:24-23)
