INTRODUCTION

- 1. Begin 2nd cycle Rv 4-8:5.
- 2. Chpt 4-5 are joined together. Worship in heaven informs the worship of church on earth: temple [cf. Ex 25:40]. Let us not be short-sighted Rv 4.

1st: John's Second Vision - 4:1-2a

- 1. Hear what HS says now see what Jn saw. After these thgs I looked... used 6 more times in Rv = sequence of the visions.
 - i. A Lord's Day? [1:10] in the Spirit & voice like sound of trumpet [4:1]
 - a. Priestly activity
 - b. 1:10 is programmatic
 - ii. "timeless" transcendent truths relevant to redemptive history on earth
- 2. what must take place after these thgs = Dan's vocab of [1:19]. Speaks of our age tw/ 1st & 2nd comings of Jesus. Already/not yet.
- 3. *a door standing open in heaven* = present but transcendent realities

2nd: John Sees the Enthroned One - 4:2b-3

- 1. Parallels w/ Dan 7 & Ezek 1. Like OT prophets, Jn is given audience w/ enthroned Lord in presence of heavenly council: commissioned [Jer 17:12]
- 2. *throne[s]* 18x in chpt 4-5. 1:4; 3:21. 1:6 we are royal priestly sons of God Most High & administer Jesus' redemptive kingdom as church w/ keys of the kingdom [Mt 16:19] in *tribulation, perseverance* [1:9].
- 3. Authority; sov'ty; rule: *Him who sits on the throne* [6:16]; prayers *before the throne* [8:3] consummated union: 22:1-4
- 4. Is there One or Two on throne? Trinity. Jn 17:5; Dan 7:13. God & the Lamb are the One.
- 5. v3 recalls visions given to Moses & prophets [esp'ly Ezek]. <u>Rv 21:16-22</u> God's throne seen as one w/ new creation.
 - i. rainbow recalls Noahic Cov
 - ii. Jn sees Jesus' throne already: our eternal destiny is certain Rv 3:21-22

3rd: The Heavenly Throne Room - 4:4-6

- 1. v4-6a immediate surroundings of THE throne v6b
- 2. Who are the "24"? OT & NT saints? Angels? Men? Symbolize God's redeemed from all redemptive history.
- 3. Jn sees a present reality promised to overcomers
 - i. <u>Rv 2:10; v26-27; 3:4-5; v11; v18; v21</u>
 - ii. This is the intermediate state. We identify w/ these citizens of heaven: their worship [Rv 5:8ff] & witness [20:4-6]. Christ' reigns already & shares rule w/ heavenly saints. What about saints on earth?
 - iii. <u>Rv 1:6</u> <u>Rv 5:8-10</u> heavenly worship: the saints
 - a. *incense* = prayers
 - b. We sing new song of praise to Lamb as priests. How is our reign on earth exercised? Worship: Jesus is Lord.
 - c. Eph 3:9-10 extol our Creator in heavenly places = Rv 4
 - d. See the heavenly setting of our worship [2Kg 6:17] Rv 4:5-6b!
- 4. v5 *lightenings & sounds & thunders* = vocab of YHWH on Sinai.

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- 5. v5 7 lamps of fire before throne = 7 Spirits of God where are we? The Holy Place of the temple! Church = lampstand by wh/ministry of HS extends into all the earth <u>Rv 5:6</u> [Grt Com].
- 6. v6 sea of glass/crystal "sea" chaos [Gn 1:2; Rv 21:1] now calm.
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Applic #1: We Celebrate & Experience our Salvation in Corporate Worship

- 1. We worship before throne!
- 2. <u>Heb 12:18-21</u> not Sinai; <u>v22-24</u> Mtn Zion

Applic #2: We Witness to What We Experience in Corporate Worship

- 1. Worship transforms us so that we can be the light of the world.
- 2. We experience Christ glorifying worship so that we witness to Christ's glory. We declare & demonstrate the truth of worship: Jesus is Lord.

Applic #3: Our Worship and Our Witness Extols the Authority of King Jesus

- 1. One sitting on throne supreme over "legal" earthly persecution
- 2. We are Sons of God Most High overcome by witness: Jesus is Lord.
- 3. Meditate on Rv 4:1-6a. Worship will make us witnesses: Jesus is Lord.
