## I. God's Provision for a Fruitful Vineyard (v.1-2)

- A. The Lord's Vineyard was Planted with LOVE (v.1)
- B. The Lord's Vineyard was Planted with OBSTACLES REMOVED (v.2a)
- C. The Lord's Vineyard was Planted with the BEST OF VINE (v.2b)
- D. The Lord's Vineyard was Planted with PROTECTION PROVIDED (v.2c)
- E. The Lord's Vineyard was Planted with MUCH ANTICIPATION (v.2d)

## II. God's Punishment of a Fruitless Vineyard (v.5-6)

- A. God's Protection is Removed (v.5)
- B. God's Cultivation & Care is Stopped (v.6)
