- Over The Last Year:
 - We've Become More & More Accustomed:
 - To Hearing Words Like:
 - "Essential!" As In:
 - "Essential Workers!" And:
 - "Unprecedented!"
 - Which Hopefully Means:
 - Everything Is Now "Precedented!"
 - So We Can Stop Using It! But Also:
 - "Virtual!" As In:
 - "Virtual Learning!"
 - For Students From Kindergarten To College! And:
 - "Virtual Work!"
 - Where People Are Working From Home Still In Their Jammies!
 - At Least From The Waist Down In Case They Have To Meet In A:
 - "Virtual Conference!"
 - But Sadly For A Time:
 - We Even Experienced:
 - "Virtual Church!"
 - But With So Much Becoming:
 - "Virtual" There Is One Thing:
 - That Has Become:
 - Ouite "Actual!"
 - And That Is:
 - Isolation & Loneliness!
- 2. In A Survey Conducted Last Year By:
 - Cigna Insurance In January, 2020 Even Before:
 - Everything Went "Virtual" Because Of The Pandemic:
 - Three In Five Americans:
 - Considered Themselves Lonely!
 - "Feeling Like They Are Left Out, Poorly Understood, And Lacking Companionship!"
 - Now If That Was Then:
 - Imagine What It Must Be Like Now!
 - Or Maybe You Don't Need To Imagine It:
 - Because You Are Experiencing It:
 - At This Very Moment!
 - You Feel Alone!
- 3. And Perhaps This Feeling:
 - Is Even More Intense For:
 - Christians As We Feel:
 - Not Only Starved:
 - For "Actual" Fellowship But Also:
 - Because We Feel:
 - Like Fewer & Fewer Are Trusting In:
 - And Testifying About:
 - The Truth!
 - No Doubt This Is How:
 - The Prophet Elijah Felt:
 - As The Wicked King Ahab & His Wife Jezebel:
 - Were Pursuing After Him:
 - In Order To Take His Life!
 - In 1 Kings 19:10:
 - He Took His Feelings Of Isolation & Discouragement To The Lord In Prayer!
 - "And he said, I have been very jealous for the LORD God of hosts: for the children of

Israel have forsaken thy covenant, thrown down thine altars, and slain thy prophets with the sword; and I, even I only, am left; and they seek my life, to take it away!"

- 4. Well As We Turn Back In Our Bibles:
 - To The Book Of Romans:
 - We Will See That The Apostle Paul:
 - Uses The Example Of Elijah & His Loneliness:
 - To Reassure God's People:
 - That With God & His Grace:
 - You Are Never Alone & You Never Need To Despair!
 - Because In Romans 11:
 - God Has Paul Continue To Refute:
 - Some Of The Excuses & Objections:
 - That People Might Have:
 - To The Message Of The Gospel!
 - In The Last Chapter:
 - He Dealt With The Question:
 - "Have They Not Heard?"
 - And His Answer Was:
 - Everyone Has Heard Something:
 - About The Greatness & The Goodness Of God!
 - He Also Dealt With The Question:
 - "Did Not Israel Know?"
 - And His Answer Was:
 - They **Did** Now:
 - About The Greatness & The Goodness Of God!
 - The Problem Was & Still Is:
 - Most Of Them Do Not Believe In:
 - The Goodness Of God:
 - Revealed Through The Gospel Of Jesus Christ!
- 5. Well In The Same Vein At The Beginning Of This New Chapter:
 - Paul Wants To Deal With This Question:
 - 11:1 "I say then, Hath God cast away his people?"
 - That Is The People Of Israel?
 - This Seems To Have Been:
 - A Real Concern!
 - Not Only In The Hearts Of:
 - Jewish Believers But Even In:
 - The Hearts Of:
 - Gentile Believers:
 - In That Multi-Ethnic Roman Church!
 - Because Didn't God Himself:
 - Make Certain Promises To Israel?
 - Not Just Conditional Promises:
 - Like The Ones He Made Through:
 - His Covenant With Moses When They Came Out Of Egypt!
 - But Also Certain Unconditional Promises:
 - Like The Ones He Made Through:
 - His Covenants With Their Fathers, Abraham & Isaac & Jacob?
 - And Yet It Seemed Like Paul Was Saying That:
 - Israel Has No More Place:
 - In God's Plan!
 - And So Those Jews:
 - Who *Did* Believe In Christ:
 - Felt Very Much Alone!
 - And Those Gentiles:
 - Who Turned To Christ:
 - May Have Wondered:
 - Can This Happen To Us?
 - Again 11:1 "I say then, Hath God cast away his people?"

- 6. Well In The Rest Of This Verse Through Verse 6:
 - The Apostle Paul Wants To Reassure All Of Us:
 - That 11:2 "God Hath *Not* Cast Away His People!"
 - He Never Has & He Never Will!
 - And So Now:
 - You Can Truly Rest In:
 - The Grace Of The Lord!

- Let's Read Together:
 - 11:1-6 "I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin. / God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, / Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. / But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal. / Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace. / And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work!"
- 7. In These Verses:
 - The Lord Wants To Remind Us & Reassure Us:
 - That His Grace:
 - Has Always Been Active!
 - Even Among Those People:
 - Who Continued To Resist & Reject Him!
 - Even Among Those Who Were:
 - 10:21 "A Disobedient And Gainsaying People!"
 - And So Now You Can Truly Rest In:
 - The Grace Of The Lord!
 - As We Go Through These Verses This Morning:
 - We Will Be Looking At 3 Marks:
 - Of God's Grace In Which:
 - You Can Trust & Rest!
 - The Promise Of His Grace!
 - The Proof Of His Grace! And:
 - The Purpose Of His Grace!
- * So First You Can Trust & Rest In:
- 1. The Promise Of God's Grace!
 - Because There Is A Promise!
 - Which Is What We Find In:
 - 11:2a In Answer To The Question Of 11:1a:
 - "Hath God cast away his people?"
 - No! "God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew!"
 - In This Answer There Is An Echo:
 - Of A Promise That God Made To:
 - The People Of Israel:
 - Back In The Old Testament!
 - In 1 Samuel 12:22:
 - God Uses The Prophet Samuel To Tell Them:
 - "For the LORD will not forsake his people for his great name's sake: because it hath pleased the LORD to make you his people!"
 - And That's A Promise!
 - In Psalm 94:14:
 - We Hear That Same Promise Repeated:
 - "For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance!"
 - And So God's Promise Is:
 - He Will:
 - Not Cast Them Away As His People!
 - To "Cast Away" Is A Very Strong Reaction:
 - To Something That Repulses You!
 - IE: Some Of You Ladies May Have An Aversion To Snakes! I Know My Mother-In-

Law Sure Does! But - Some Of You Guys Do Too - You Just Don't Want To Admit It! But - If Somebody Brought A Snake Up To You - If You Couldn't Run Away, You'd Do Whatever You Could To "Cast [It] Away!" Because You Hate Snakes!

- Well There's Nothing That Repulses God More:
 - Than Sin And Especially The Sin:
 - Of Unbelief Which Caused Even The People Of Israel:
 - To Turn From Him & His Greatness & His Goodness!
- If Anyone Had A Reason:
 - To "Cast Away His People" It Was God!
 - But He Did Not! Why? Because He:
- Has Chosen Them As His People!
 - As Paul Tells Us In 11:2 He "Foreknew" Them!"
 - Now We've Seen This Word Before:
 - In The Book Of Romans In 8:29:
 - Referring To Christians!
 - But What Does This Mean?
 - When Foreknowledge Is Used Of God:
 - All Of His Attributes Must Be Considered:
 - In Order To Understand It!
 - It Not Only Means:
 - A *Prior* Knowledge:
 - About Them!
 - Since God Is Omniscient & Knows The End From The Beginning! (Isaiah 46:10)
 - It Also Means:
 - A Particular Knowledge:
 - *Of* Them!
 - Since God Is Omnipotent & Will Bring To Pass:
 - His Eternal Purpose & Plan For This World!
 - To "Foreknow" Israel Means He Chose Israel:
 - For No Other Reason:
 - Than To Display His Love & Grace:
 - To Them & Through Them!
 - In Deuteronomy 7:7-8:
 - Moses Reminded Israel That:
 - "The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye were the fewest of all people: / But because the LORD loved you, and because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers!"
 - God Chose Israel To Be His People:
 - Not Because Of Anything He Saw In Them:
 - But Simply Because:
 - He Wanted To Set His Love Upon Them!
- And This Is Why:
 - You Can Rest In The Promise Of God's Grace!
 - God's Promise Is Not A "Virtual" Promise!
 - It Is An "Actual" Promise!
 - Because What God Promises:
 - He Is "Able Also To Perform!"
 - And What Was True For Israel:
 - Is Also True:
 - For You:
 - If You Are Trusting In Jesus As Your Savior!
 - As 11:2a "God Hath Not Cast Away His People Which He Foreknew!"
 - So Also He Will Not "Cast Away" You!
 - And You Can Rest In:
 - The Promise Of God's Grace!

^{*} But Then - Second - You Can Trust & Rest In:

2. The Proof Of God's Grace!

- Because There Is Proof!
 - And This Is What We Find:
 - At The End Of 11:1 And:
 - In The Rest Of 11:2-4!
 - This Is The Proof Of God's Grace!
 - First Paul Wants To Remind Us Of His Own:
- Individual History:
 - As The Proof Of God's Grace:
 - To His People!
 - 11:1 "I say then, Hath God cast away his people? God forbid. For I also am an Israelite, of the seed of Abraham, of the tribe of Benjamin!"
 - In The Strongest Possible Way:
 - Paul Wants To Put A Stop:
 - To This Kind Of Thinking!
 - "God Forbid" He Says!
 - And He Offers Himself!
 - His History & His Heritage:
 - As The First Example Of:
 - God Keeping His Promises:
 - To Israel!

- Paul Was:
 - "An Israelite, Of The Seed Of Abraham, Of The Tribe Of Benjamin!"
 - In Philippians 3:5 He Adds Even More To His Story!
 - So Even Though This Was Not:
 - All He Was As A Christian!
 - This Was Still *Part*:
 - Of Who He Was!
- And The Fact That:
 - God Chose & Called & Saved Him:
 - As An Israelite:
 - Proves That God Has Kept His Promise Of Grace!
- But Then Paul Also Wants To Remind Us Of:
- Israel's History:
 - As The Proof Of God's Grace:
 - To His People!
 - And Especially The Story Of:
 - Elijah From 1 Kings 18-19!
 - 11:2-4 "God hath not cast away his people which he foreknew. Wot ye not what the scripture saith of Elias? how he maketh intercession to God against Israel, saying, / Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life. / But what saith the answer of God unto him? I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal!"
 - Now The Entire Life-Story Of Elijah:
 - Is Fascinating & Provides The Backdrop:
 - To These Verses!
 - So After Elijah:
 - Had Just Experienced A Major Victory:
 - Against The False Worship Of Baal:
 - On Mount Carmel!
 - Where 450 Prophets Of Baal:
 - Were Slain!
 - The Wicked Queen Jezebel:
 - Put A Price On His Head And Said:
 - 1 Kings 19:2 "So let the gods do to me, and more also, if I make not thy life as the life of one of them by to morrow about this time!"
 - So Elijah Ran For His Life!
 - And God Eventually Led Him Back To:
 - Mount Horeb The Same Place:
 - Where God Formed His People Into A Nation:

- And Gave Him His Law!
- And While He Hid In A Cave:
 - Feeling Isolated & Even Abandoned:
 - He Cried Out To The Lord!
 - And He Made 3:
- Charges To The Lord:
 - Against His Own People & Even The Leaders Of His People!
 - 11:3 "Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars and they seek my life!"
 - All Of Which Were True!
 - But He Also Expressed To The Lord:
 - The Feelings Of His Own Heart, In A:
- Complaint To The Lord!
 - 11:3 "And I Am Left Alone!"
 - And There Was Nothing "Virtual" About His Loneliness!
 - It Was Very Actual & Very Real!
 - And How Did The Lord Respond? See The:
- Concern Of The Lord:
 - In 11:4 "I have reserved to myself seven thousand men, who have not bowed the knee to the image of Baal!"
- In This Response:
 - Not Only Does The Lord Shows His Great Concern:
 - For His Prophet!
 - To Comfort Him In His Loneliness!
 - But He Also Shows His Concern:
 - For His People, His Promises To Them:
 - And Even His Own Praise & Glory!
 - "I Have Reserved To Myself!"
 - And In This Response:
 - We Find Even More:
 - Proof Of God's Grace!
 - Grace To Elijah:
 - In His Time Of Loneliness & Distress!
 - But Also:
 - Grace To His People:
 - In Spite Of Their Continual Disobedience & Unbelief!
- And So Even When You Start To Wonder:
 - About God & His Greatness & His Goodness:
 - By Thinking:
 - Is God Able? Or:
 - Does God Care?
 - Remember That There Is Ample Proof & Testimony:
 - About God's Grace!
 - And This Proof Is Not "Virtual" Proof!
 - It Is "Actual" Proof!
 - Just Look To:
 - The Testimony Of God's Scripture And:
 - The Testimony Of God's Saints!
 - So That Now Not Only Can You Rest In:
 - The Promise Of God's Grace!
 - You Can Also Trust & Rest In:
 - The Proof Of God's Grace!
- * But Then Third You Can Also Rest In:
- 3. The Purpose Of God's Grace!
 - Because God Has A Purpose!
 - And This Is What Paul Tells Us In:
 - 11:5 "Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace!"

- The Examples That Paul Just Gave Us:
 - About His Own:
 - Individual History!
 - As Well As:
 - Israel's History!
- Not Only Teach Us:
 - *That* God Will Keep:
 - His Promises To His People!
- They Also Show Us:
 - How God Keeps:
 - His Promises To His People!
- It Is By Providing & Keeping:
 - For Himself:
 - "A Remnant!"
 - "There Is A Remnant!"
 - This Is The Purpose Of God's Grace!
- IE: One Of Ancient Israel's Most Prized Natural Treasures Was The Judean Date Palm Tree! All Along The Jordan River Valley, There Was A Vast Forest Of These Trees Standing 40 Feet Tall! And Their Large, Sweet Dates Were Harvested Year After Hear! Well, After Israel's Revolt Against Rome In The First Century Which Led To The Destruction Of Jerusalem & The Temple Itself The Romans Also Directed Their Wrath Against The Economy Of Israel Which Included The Almost Complete Destruction Of Those Palm Trees!
- However, In One Of The Last Jewish Strongholds Against The Romans The Great Fortress Of Masada Some Forward-Thinking Jewish Rebel Preserved Some Seeds From Those Trees! And Even Though Masada Fell The Clay Jar Which Held Those Seeds Remained For 2,000 Years!
 In 1963 That Jar Was Found! And In 2005, A Scientist Wanted To See What Would Happen If She Planted One Of Those Seeds! And Then To Everyone's Great Surprise It Started To Grow! The Judean Date Palm Was No Longer Extinct! Why? Because There Was Still Life & Food In That Seed!
 - That Tree Which They Named Methuselah Now Stands More Than 10 Feet High And Has Been Joined With Other Trees Grown From Other Seeds From That Same Jar! And Together They Have Produced The First Harvest Of Judean Palm Dates In Over 2,000 Years!
- And This Too Is The Purpose Of God For His People! Even Though Everything Around You May Seem To Be Against You! Even Though You Feel Like You Are Dry & Dusty & About To Die! "There Is A Remnant!" God Preserves A Remnant! Just Like The Seeds In That Old Jar So That In His Time God's People Might Grow & Flourish Again! Why? Because There's Still Life In Those Seeds!
 - When You Turn To & Trust In Jesus Christ Who Died For You & Your Sin And Who Came Back To Life In Triumph Over Your Sin His Spiritual Life Is Planted In The Seed Of Your Heart! This Is The Purpose Of God For His People! And:
- There Is A Great Strength In God's Purpose!
 - It Provides Great Comfort:
 - To His People!
 - Which Can You Can See In The Words:
 - Paul Uses In These Verses!
 - In 11:3 When Elijah Brought His Complaint:

To The Lord - What Did He Say?

- "I Am Left!"

- But Then:

- In 11:4 - How Did The Lord Respond?

- "I Have Reserved" - Or:

- "I Have Left!"

- And Now:

- In 11:5 What Does Paul Say?
 - "There Is A Remnant!" Or:
 - "There Is Left!"
- This Is The Purpose Of God:
 - For His People!
 - He Will Always Keep For Himself:
 - A Remnant!
 - This Was True:

- In The Past And This Is True:
 - In The Present!
- In The Case Of Israel:
 - This Remnant Is:
 - God's Promise Fulfilled And:
 - God's Pledge To Remain Faithful!
- But Who Is This Remnant?
 - It Is A Living Group Of People:
 - Left In This World To:
 - Worship Him! And To:
 - Witness For Him!
- This Remnant Is:
 - The True Israel Of God!
 - The Spiritual Israel:
 - Who Believe In Jesus Christ As Their Messiah & As Their Savior!
 - They Are The Ones:
 - To Whom God's Promises Were Made!
 - 9:6 "For they are not all Israel, which are of Israel!"
- This Is & Has Always Been:
 - The Purpose Of God!
 - But We Also See In 11:5 That:
- There Is A Great Source For God's Purpose!
 - God's Remnant Is:
 - "According To The Election Of Grace!"
 - God's Choice Is & Has Always Been:
 - Based On His Grace!
 - His Own Will & Pleasure:
 - To "Shew Mercy On Whom [He] Will Shew Mercy!"
 - When God Chose:
 - Noah & His Family:
 - To Preserve Life In This World:
 - It Was All Because Of:
 - His Purpose & Grace!
 - Genesis 6:8 "But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD!"
 - When God Chose:
 - Abraham & Sarah:
 - To Bless & To Be A Blessing:
 - It Was All Because Of:
 - His Own Purpose & Grace!
 - When God Chose:
 - The People Of Israel:
 - To Give Unto Them Countless Privileges:
 - Including Sending His Son Into This World Through Them!
 - It Was All Because Of:
 - His Own Purpose & Grace! And:
 - When God Chose:
 - To Preserve A Remnant:
 - *From* Israel In Order To:
 - Fulfil His Promises *To* Israel:
 - Once Again It Was All Because Of:
 - His Own Purpose & Grace!
 - But Then We Also See In 11:6 That:
- There Is A Great Security In God's Purpose!
 - 11:6 "And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work!"
 - This Verses Teaches Us:
 - That Since God's Grace Is The Foundation:
 - For His Choice:
 - Then God's Grace Is The Only Way:

- For Salvation!

- God's Grace:
 - Puts Everyone:
 - On A Level Playing Field! Because:
 - Grace Excludes Works And:
 - Works Excludes Grace!
- This Means That:
 - In Order For Grace:
 - To Be Grace:
 - There Can Be Nothing Added:
 - To Grace!
- It Must Be Pure Grace!
 - And God's Grace:
 - Is Pure!
- The Purpose Of God's Choice:
 - Has Been & Will Always Be:
 - Based On Nothing But:
 - His Own Amazing Grace!
 - And His Purpose Is Not A "Virtual" Purpose!
 - It Is An "Actual" Purpose!
 - This Means:
 - That Even Though:
 - You May Feel "Left" Or:
 - You May Even **Be** "Left!"
 - You Are Never Alone!
 - When You Trust In Jesus Christ:
 - His Own Life Is In The Seed Of Your Heart:
 - Never To Die Again!

Conclusion:

- 1. So Now You Can Truly Rest In:
 - The Grace Of The Lord!
 - Because If You Are Saved:
 - "By Grace Through Faith" Then:
 - "Is It No More Of Works!"
- 2. And Now You Can Rest Completely In:
 - The Promise Of His Grace!
 - The Proof Of His Grace! And:
 - The Purpose Of His Grace!
- 3. And In His Grace:
 - Though There May Be Times:
 - You Feel Lonely!
 - The Truth Is:
 - You Are Never Alone!

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
