Responsive Reading

Leader: Which is the third commandment?

People: The third commandment is, Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

Leader: What is required in the third commandment?

People: The third commandment requires the holy and reverent use of God’s names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works.

Leader: What is forbidden in the third commandment?

People: The third commandment forbids all profaning or abusing of anything whereby God makes himself known. (Shorter Catechism 53-55)

Corporate Confession of Sin

Leader: Lord God Almighty, we confess that we have not treated your names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word and works with proper reverence and awe.

People: We confess that we have indeed abused your name and titles, forgotten your holy attributes, failed to attend to your ordinances and Word, and have not acknowledged your mighty works for us.

All: Forgive us, Lord, for your name’s sake; teach us your ways and make yourself known to us so that we might worship you as we ought.
