

### Genesis 1:11-13

And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, *and* the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind, whose seed *is* in itself, upon the earth: and it was so.

<sup>12</sup> And the earth brought forth grass, *and* herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed *was* in itself, after his kind: and God saw that *it was* good.

<sup>13</sup> And the evening and the morning were the third day.

### Genesis 1:30

And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creepeth upon the earth, wherein *there is* life, *I have given* every green herb for meat: and it was so.

### Examples of God’s creative genius:

**1. Photosynthesis** – The complex and amazing ability of plants, trees, and grass to turn the energy of the sun into energy we need. Humans and animals depend of this because we have no way of getting the suns energy ourselves.

**2. Desert Rhubarb** – A plant in the Negev Desert that can catch water 16 times more efficiently than other plants, enabling it to flourish in one of the driest places on earth.

**3. Bladderworts** – Incredible carnivorous plants that capture and digest small creatures.

**4. A fig tree and fig wasp** show a symbiotic relationship – one dependent on the other for reproduction. This also shows that the days of creation were literal days and evolution could not have happened.

**5. A Trophism** is the amazing ability of a plant, tree, or grass to know to put it’s roots down into the earth and it’s shoots up into the sky (gravitropism), to grow towards light (phototropism), and to be able to cling to objects (thigmotropism).
