Preparation for Judgment: A Scroll Revelation 5:1-14 (part 2)

- I. <u>WONDERING</u>: "Who is worthy to open the scroll?" (5:1-7)
 - A. Scroll: "in the right hand...a scroll" (v.1)
 - B. Search: "Who is worthy to open?" (vv.2-3)
 - C. Solution: "stop weeping...behold, the Lion" (vv.4-5)
 - D. Savior: "a Lamb standing, as if slain" (vv.6-7)

II. <u>WORSHIPING</u>: "Worthy art Thou" (5:8-14)

- A. Authorization: "a new song" (vv.8-10)
 - Worship: "fell down before the Lamb" (v.8)
 a. Present: "four living beings and twenty-four elders"
 - b. Praise: "having each ... a harp and golden bowls of incense"
 - 2. Worth: "sang a new song" (v.9)a. Right: "Worthy art Thou to take...to break..."
 - b. Reason: "for Thou wast slain...didst purchase..."

3. Work: "made...they will reign" (v.10)a. Right: "Thou hast made them...a kingdom and priests"

b. Rule: "they will reign upon the earth"

B. Acclamation: "a loud voice" (vv.11-14)

- One: "Worthy is the Lamb" (vv.11-12)

 a. Present: "many angels...living beings...the elders"
 - b. Proclaming: "Worthy is the lamb...to receive..."
- 2. Both: "To Him...on the throne, and to the Lamb" (vv.13-14)a. Present: "every created thing (creature)"
 - b. Proclaiming: "blessing...honor...glory...dominion"
 - b. Prostrate: "fell down and worshiped"
