

Fulfilling Our Church Ministry
Romans 15:18–21

The Great Commission is the mission of the church.

For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, to make the Gentiles obedient—in mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God,

- A Christian minister's boast is that through him, Christ has brought about disciples who are obeying Him - **1 Thessalonians 2:19–20**
- The mighty signs and wonders refer to the miraculous power of the Spirit of God given to the apostles to confirm their message - **2 Corinthians 12:12 Truly the signs of an apostle were accomplished among you with all perseverance, in signs and wonders and mighty deeds.**
- The power of the Spirit of God was not only in the signs and wonders but also in his preaching and testimony of the gospel of Christ - **2 Timothy 1:13–14 Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. That good thing which was committed to you, keep by the Holy Spirit who dwells in us.**

so that from Jerusalem and round about to Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

- Paul ministered in an arch the encompassed the eastern half of the Roman Empire.
- Paul considered this area reached even though he did not preach in every city, even though there was not a church planted in every city, and even though his converts were not fully discipled.

And so I have made it my aim to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build on another man's foundation, but as it is written: "TO WHOM HE WAS NOT ANNOUNCED, THEY SHALL SEE; AND THOSE WHO HAVE NOT HEARD SHALL UNDERSTAND."

- Paul was working to complete the apostolic mission Christ had given him - **Ephesians 2:20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone,**
- Paul was not only motivated by his compassion for lost souls but for his apostolic calling to establish a foundation for the church.
- Evangelism and church planting to unreached peoples is foundation work.
- The prophetic word confirms the calling of God to every generation of Christians to preach the gospel and plant churches all over the world to people who have never heard the gospel of Christ (*Isaiah 52:13–15*).
- A missionary gets his confidence and motivation to do foundation work from the promise that some will believe the gospel and receive Christ as Lord and Savior.

Brother and sister, our apostle Paul fulfilled his ministry, now as a church we must fulfill our ministry - **2 Timothy 4:5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.**
