A A	Jesus: "Was the baptism of John from or from?" If they admit that John the Baptist was from God, they will be forced to acknowledge that Jesus is (see John 1:29). If they say that John the Baptist was from man, they will the people. So they say, "We don't know if John was from God or from man." This is their answer, not because they don't the truth, but because they are of the people (verse 32).
