The Failures of Peter - v.69-74	
Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard. And a servant girl came up to him and said, "You also were with Jesus the Galilean." But he denied it before them all, saying, "I do not know what you mean."	
And when he went out to the entrance, another servant girl saw him, and	
she said to the bystanders, "This man was with Jesus of <i>Nazareth</i> ." And again he denied it <i>with an oath</i> : "I do not know the man."	
After a little while the bystanders came up and said to Peter, "Certainly	
you too are one of them, for your accent betrays you." Then he began to invoke a curse [on himself] and to swear, "I do not know the man."

The Betrayer's Regret - v.3-5	
Then when Judas, his <i>betrayer</i> , saw that Jesus was condemned, he <i>changed his mind</i> and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the	
chief priests and the elders, saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood."	
They said, "What is that to us? See to it yourself." And <i>throwing down</i> the pieces of silver into the temple, he <i>departed</i> , and he went and <i>hanged</i> himself.

The Leaders' Hypocrisy - v.6-10	
But the chief priests, taking the pieces of silver, said, "It is <i>not lawful</i> to put them into the treasury, since it is blood money."	
So they <i>took counsel</i> and <i>bought</i> with them the potter's field as a burial place for strangers.	
Therefore that field has been called the <i>Field of Blood</i> to this day.	
Then was <i>fulfilled</i> what had been spoken by the prophet <i>Jeremiah</i> , saying, "And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him on whom a price had been set by some of the sons of Israel, and they gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord directed me."
