How do you measure love? What is great love?

Christ died for the powerless, v 6.

Christ died for the ungodly, v 6

Christ died for sinners, v 8

Christ died for enemies, v 10

Jesus came to save, not the righteous, but sinners.

Conviction of sin is essential to salvation.

You must have a personal knowledge of sin, weakness and need.

Satan came to crush my conscience not too long ago.

For a good person one would dare even to die.

Christ died for his enemies; not his friends or family.

What is a 'qal wahomer?'

It is an argument from the light to the heavy; or the heavy to the light.

If God did the heavy work in justifying us when we were still sinners, and reconciling us when we were enemies, how much more will he do the lighter thing in leading us to glory now that we are friends.

Why do we rejoice so little in God? What are we lacking joy?
