Can anxiety lengthen your life?

Your times are in God's hands, not your own

Won't God clothe you?

Trust your heavenly Father Who clothes the lilies with glory

What are you seeking?

Seek God's Kingdom and righteousness above your basic needs

For 4-18-10 sermon

"Winning Over Worry" Matthew 6:25-34

Why How will the crucial choices we make (6:19-24) affect our ability to live free from worry (6:25)?

According to Jesus, why are we foolish to worry about physical and material needs (6:25-30)? How does worry reveal a lack of faith?

Since God promises to feed and clothe His children, why are many of them ill-clad and undernourished (see Matt.25:41-45)?

Give examples of how people today "run after" things like food and clothing (6:32). Why should we be free from those trivial pursuits?

Why and how are our ambitions and priorities to be different from those of non-Christians (6:32-34)? Is this true of your life? Why/why not?
