- outline of Romans 9-11

1. Paul’s concern (9:1-5)

- Paul’s deep burden
- his “wish”
Ex. 32:32; Rom. 8:1, 39
- the privileges of the Jews
Ex. 4:22; Gal. 3:16



2. God’s choice (9:6-13)

- there have always been two “Israels”
Rom. 2:28-29; Jn. 8:39-41
- example #1: Ishmael v. Isaac
Gen. 17:18
- example #2: Esau v. Jacob
+ basis of God’s choice

+ God’s love and “hatred”
Lk. 14:26
- choice of salvation belongs to God alone
Jn. 13:18; 15:16; 17:6, 9; 1 Thess. 1:4; 2 Thess. 2:13
- correcting misunderstandings regarding election
+ God never “saves” one who is unwilling

+ those whom God “passes over” *never* honestly desire to be with Christ

APPLICATION

- the doctrines of grace are controversial
- the doctrines of grace are crucial
+ God is most greatly glorified

+ they are the greatest impetus to missions & evangelism
