FURTHER CONSIDERATIONS


Luke 2:41-52. What do you think Jesus' parents were feeling just before they found Him in the temple? What is Mary's response when she sees Jesus? Was she pleased with Him? How do you reconcile the command to honor father and mother with Jesus' behavior in this passage? How does verse 49 apply to Jesus' honoring His parents?

John 2:1-5. What might the presence of Jesus, His mother, and His disciples at the wedding indicate? What does Mary's concern for the hosting situation at the wedding imply about her involvement? How do you know that Jesus' reply was not disrespectful? What does His answer indicate about His greater purpose? Read John 7:6, 30; 8:20; 12:27; 13:1; and 17:1. What do these verses reveal about Christ's purpose? How can you understand God's purpose for your life?

Ephesians 6:1-4. What are the two commands for children given in these verses? What promises are stated? What is the stated responsibility for parents? What are some practical ways to bring up children "in the training and admonition of the Lord"? How does Tri-City Baptist Church seek to assist parents? How can you personally advance the training of the next generation of servants for the Lord? Will you pray specifically for our parents to have wisdom? Pray for our children to grow to love the Lord and to serve the Lord (Deuteronomy 10:12-13).
