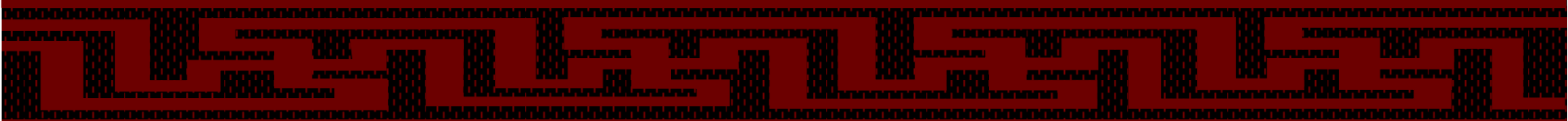

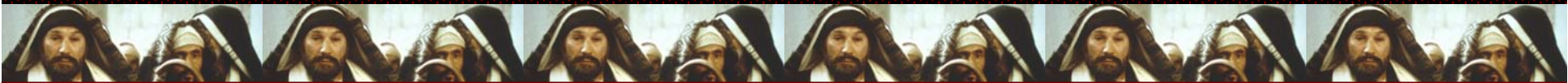




## 2. Christ's Cleansing of the Temple 19:45-48

3. Religious leaders hypocrisy



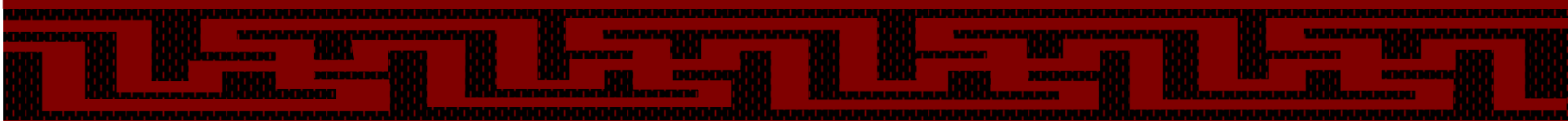


# 1. Jesus defies the Religious Leaders Authority 20:1-8

“Was the Baptist of John from heaven or from man?” 20:4





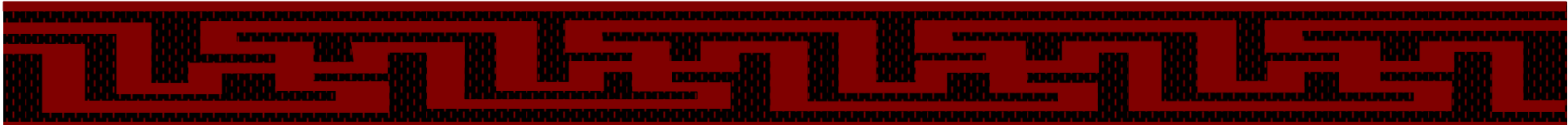

“ Then render to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s, and to God the things that are God’s” v. 25





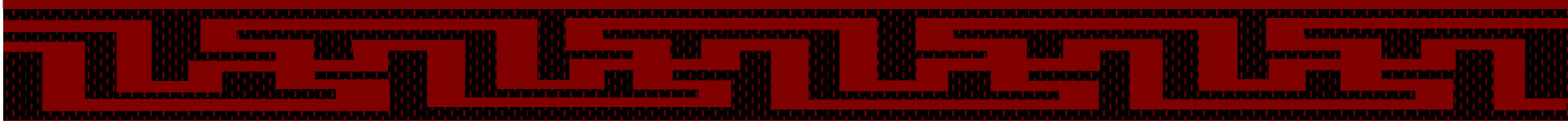


