The Personhood of the Holy Spirit

- He has intellect - knows the thoughts of God (1 Cor. 2:11) and has a mind (Rom. 8:27)
- He has emotion - can be grieved (Eph. 4:30)
- He has will - distributes spiritual gifts to the church according to His will (1 Cor. 12:11)
- He teaches (Lk. 12:12; 14:26)
- He testifies (Jn. 15:26; Rom. 8:16)
- He leads and directs (Mt. 4:1; Acts; 13:4; 16:6-7; Rom. 8:14)
- He gives guidance (Mk. 13:11; Acts 15:28)
- He convicts (John 16:7-8)
- He speaks (Acts 8:29; 10:19; 13:2; 20:23; 21:11; 1 Tim. 4:1; Rev. 22:17)
- He intercedes (Rom. 8:26)

The Deity of the Holy Spirit

- He is called the Spirit of God (Ezek. 11:24; Mt. 3:16)
- He is called the Spirit of Jesus (Acts 16:7; Gal. 4:6; Phil. 1:19; 1 Pet. 1:11)
- He is named as part of the Trinitarian baptism formula (Mt. 28:19)
- He is eternal (Heb. 9:14)
- He is omniscient (1 Cor. 2:10-11)
- He is omnipresent (Ps. 139:7)
- He is omnipotent (Gen. 1:2; Job 33:4)
- He is truth (1 Jn. 5:6)
- He is the One Who inspired the Scriptures (2 Pet. 1:21; 2 Tim. 3:16)
- He is the One Who regenerates lost sinners (Jn. 3:6; Titus 3:5)
- He is the One Who gives life (Rom. 8:2)
- He is God (Acts 3-4; 2 Cor. 3:17)
