He Sat Down

The significance of Jesus being seated at the right hand of Majesty
Hebrews 1:2b-3

Introduction: Passover's 4th Question: Why on this night do we recline?

Seven facts demonstrating the Supremacy of Christ

He is the heir of all things (Psalm 2)

He created the universe (John 1:1-3, Col 1:15-16)

He holds all things together by His Word (Col 1:17)

He is the radiance of God's glory (illustration: the sun and its rays)

He is the image of the essence of God (Hypostatic Union)

He is the great high priest who made purification for sins

He is the King of kings who sat down at the right hand of Majesty

He Sat Down

He ... being the radiance of God's glory ... and exact representation of God's nature ... sat down at the right hand of Majesty.

He ... upholding all things by the word of His power ... sat down at the right hand of Majesty.

He ... having made purification of sins sat down at the right hand of Majesty.

Isaiah 6 – Jesus in the throne room of heaven

The implications of Jesus sitting down

Honor (Worship Him)
Authority / Royalty (Obey Him as Lord)
Rest (Rest in His finished work)
Intercession (Pray confidently)
