- I. Grace and Peace – vs. 3
  - A. Grace
    - 1. That which adds joy, favor that brings delight, ‘a benefit conferred freely as expression of good will’
    - 2. Blessed by Divine favor
    - 3. Paul uses the word 100 times out of 155 times it is used in the NT
  - B. Peace
    - 1. A cessation of hostilities, harmony, a state of well-being especially related to others
    - 2. A reminder that we are enemies of God and need peace with Him
    - 3. Grace is how we get peace
  - C. From God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ
- II. The Cross – vs. 4
  - A. The Willingness to go to the Cross – John 10:17-18; Matt. 27:50
    - 1. He gave Himself – Eph. 5:25; Titus 2:14
    - 2. The Father gave Him – unity in purpose – Rom. 8:32
  - B. The Purpose of the Cross
    - 1. He gave Himself for our sins – 1 Cor. 15:3
    - 2. Substitution, atonement – Psa. 79:9; 1 Peter 3:18
    - 3. Propitiation – Rom. 3:24-26; 1 John 4:10
  - C. The Effect of the Cross
    - 1. To Deliver us from this present evil age – Matt. 6:13; Eph. 5:15-17
    - 2. Freed, rescued, redeemed
      - a. From sin’s penalty – Rom. 6:5-11
      - b. From sin’s power – Rom. 6:12-14
    - 3. We live in a realm we’ve been rescued from – 1 Peter 2:9-10
      - a. The World System – 1 John 2:15-17
      - b. The World’s Ways – 2 Cor. 6:14-18

    - 1. The cross was God’s plan all along – Acts 2:23; 1 Peter 1:20; Eph. 1:3-6
    - 2. Our salvation is according to God’s will – John 1:13; Eph. 1:11; Psa. 115:3; 135:6

  - A. Forever and Ever – Psa. 50:15; John 12:28; 21:19
  - B. Amen – So let it be, so it is – 1 Tim. 1:16-17

### **John 10:17-18**

17 “Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. 18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father.”

### **Matthew 27:50**

50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit.

### **Ephesians 5:25**

25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her,

### **Titus 2:14**

14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

### **Romans 8:32**

32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

### **1 Corinthians 15:3**

3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

### **Psalms 79:9**

9 Help us, O God of our salvation, For the glory of Your name; And deliver us, and provide atonement for our sins, For Your name's sake!

### **1 Peter 3:18**

18 For Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit,

### **Romans 3:24-26**

24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, 26 to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

### **1 John 4:10**

10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

### **Matthew 6:13**

13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

### **Ephesians 5:15-17**

15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, 16 redeeming the time, because the days are evil. 17 Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is.

### **Romans 6:5-14**

5 For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection, 6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. 7 For he who has died has been freed from sin. 8 Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, 9 knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. 10 For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. 11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. 13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. 14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

### **1 Peter 2:9-10**

9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; 10 who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

### **1 John 2:15-17**

15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. 17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

### **2 Corinthians 6:14-18**

14 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? 15 And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever? 16 And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people." 17 Therefore "Come out from among them and be

separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you.” 18 “I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.”

### **Colossians 2:20-23**

20 Therefore, if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world, why, as though living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations— 21 “Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle,” 22 which all concern things which perish with the using—according to the commandments and doctrines of men? 23 These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but are of no value against the indulgence of the flesh.

### **Acts 2:23**

23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;

### **1 Peter 1:20**

20 He indeed was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you

### **Ephesians 1:3-6**

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, 4 just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, 5 having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, 6 to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

### **John 1:13**

13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

### **Ephesians 1:11**

11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will,

### **Psalms 115:3**

3 But our God is in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.

### **Psalms 135:6**

6 Whatever the Lord pleases He does, In heaven and in earth, In the seas and in all deep places.

### **Psalms 50:15**

15 Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me.”

**John 12:28**

28 Father, glorify Your name.” Then a voice came from heaven, saying, “I have both glorified it and will glorify it again.”

**John 21:19**

19 This He spoke, signifying by what death he would glorify God. And when He had spoken this, He said to him, “Follow Me.”

**1 Timothy 1:16-17**

16 However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life. 17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.
