The Showdown by the Sea Mark 5:1-20

One Main Point: Jesus is the sovereign Lord and promised Messiah.

Scene 1: Two Spirit-Empowered Men Face Off

- Gadara: A **Gentile** region on the eastern side of the sea of Galilee
- The tomb-dweller charges toward Jesus
 - Mark's vivid description
- The unclean Spirit **submits**—and with a high Christology.
- A **demonic** prayer request
 - o "I adjure you by God!" | A reverse-exorcism attempt
 - o Legion, the demon-beggar
 - Prayer request granted!
 - Jesus, the demon-drowner

Scene 2: An Ironic, Tragic Response

- Fear instead of **relief** or gratitude
 - The replay
- The demons beg for permission to stay, the townspeople beg for Jesus **to depart**.
 - The townspeople would rather have order and safety than an omnipotent Savior.

Scene 3: The Third Beggar

- Jesus heads out
- A **petition** to be on Jesus' ministry team
- Request *not* granted—there is another path.
 - o Deliverance proclaimed in the **Decapolis**

Encountering the Messiah

- Which one is greater in our lives—**fear of the Lord** or fear of... anything else?
- Are we content with joining Jesus **on mission** in ways that don't feel thrilling or fit our preferred picture of service to God?
