INTRODUCTION: WHAT DESPERATE PEOPLE DO

Nobody really likes being desperate.

Despair

the complete loss or absence of hope

? How do you respond to desperation?

In Psalm 61, David's prescription for desperate people is to cling to the God of salvation and to cling to the salvation that only comes through Christ.

Proposition: God is a savior so that desperate people can rest in Jesus Christ and His salvation.

I. DESPERATION

A. GODLY DESPERATION LEADS TO PRAYER, VV. 1,2

You cannot pray properly except from a point of desperation.

Psalm 42:11

Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God.

Leviticus 17:6

B. GOLDY DESPERATION HOPES IN GOD'S SALVATION,

Point Desperation leads to prayer.

But God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

My flesh and my heart may fail,

And besides You, I desire nothing on earth.

Whom have I in heaven but You?

Psalms 73:25, 26

Goldy desperation is desperate dependence.

APPLICATION:

Conversion, prayer, sanctification.
