The Apostles' Creed

{The articles of our common and undoubted Christian faith}

1. *I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.*
2. *And in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord;*
3. *Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary;*
4. *Suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried;*
He descended into hell.
5. *On the third day He arose from the dead;*
6. *He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father almighty;*
7. *From there He will come to judge the living and the dead.*
8. *I believe in the Holy Spirit;*
9. *I believe a holy catholic Christian Church, the communion of saints;*
10. *The forgiveness of sins;*
11. *The resurrection of the body;*
12. *And the life everlasting. Amen.*

The Heidelberg Catechism

26. Q. What do you believe when you say: *I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?*

A. That the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who out of nothing created heaven and earth and all that is in them,[1] and who still upholds and governs them by His eternal counsel and providence,[2] is, for the sake of Christ His Son, my God and my Father.[3] In Him I trust so completely as to have no doubt that He will provide me with all things necessary for body and soul,[4] and will also turn to my good whatever adversity He sends me in this life of sorrow.[5] He is able to do so as almighty God,[6] and willing also as a faithful Father.[7]

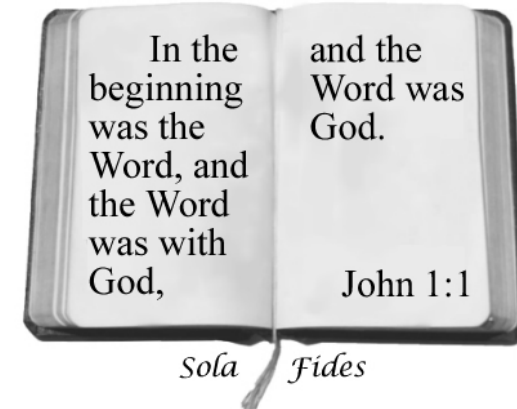

Sermon: Apostle's Creed Article 1 [part 1]

Questions for discussion:

1. What does it mean that true Christian faith is a *catholic/common faith* and *undoubted faith*?
2. What must we “presuppose” about God?
Why must we presuppose this?
How does this affect our talking to unbelievers?
3. How did God create heaven and earth and all that is in them (except for man)?
4. What is the problem with any idea of “evolution?”
Why is “theistic evolution” still unbiblical and thus unscientific?
5. Why can science not speak about “origins?” What is the only starting point for science, so we have “true science?”
6. Why is it important to understand that God created a “mature universe?”
7. What is the only way we can come to know God the Creator as “my God?” How does this benefit us?
8. Why is it that true salvation is only found in knowing God as “my almighty God?”
