Introduction

- The power of personal stories to substantiate claims!
- Paul's opponents attacked the MAN—his apostleship, and his MESSAGE, particularly the source of his message.
- Paul's bold claims:
 - His apostleship was not "from men, through a man, but through Jesus Christ."—Galatians 1:1
 - His message was not "according to man, nor received by man, nor taught it, but received through revelation"—Galatians 1:11-12
- Paul claims to be an independent contractor!

Paul's Claims = His Story?

- A. Paul's Jewish Upbringing = NOTHING Galatians 1:13-14
 - 1. His Jewish pedigree—Philippians 3:4-6
 - 2. Educated under Gamaliel, the top rabbi of his day—Acts 22:3
 - 3. Advancing beyond his contemporaries, Galatians 1:14 especially in regards to the "traditions of my fathers". A quintessential legalist!
 - 4. Mission in life: Persecute the church –Galatians 1:13
 - a. Defied the religious tolerance of his mentor—Acts 5:35-36
 - b. Hatred for Christians first surfaced at Stephen's trial-Acts 7
 - c. Intent on wiping out Christianity—Acts 26:9-11
 - 5. His Jewish upbringing prepared him to be the chief Judaizer.

B. Paul's Personal Encounter with Christ = EVERYTHING

- 1. The Historical Recounting of the Encounter—Acts 9:1-9
 - a. Very unusual or unique conversion experience
 - b. The end result of a long process—under "conviction"
 - c. Jesus encounters the risen Christ—changed his life!
- 2. The Theological Recounting of the Encounter—Galatians 1:15-16
 - a. God set him apart from birth—Jeremiah 1:5; Isaiah 49:1; Luke 1
 - b. God called him through His grace. 1Thess. 1:4-5
 - 1) Responded with repentance of his sin
 - 2) Responded with repudiation of self-righteousness- Phil 3
 - c. Called and set apart for two purposes
 - 1) "To reveal Ĥis Son in Me"—ĈONVERSION Gal. 1:15
 - a) Christian life = "Christ in you!"
 - b) "Not a religion, but a personal relationship"
 - 2) "To preach Him among the Gentiles"—COMMISSION 1:16
 - a) Commission direct from Jesus—Acts 26:15-18
 - b) Our commission—Ephesians 2:10; 1 Peter 2:9
- 3. Owes everything to GRACE—1 Timothy 1:12-15; 1 Cor. 15:9-10
