Introduction

"And I was with you in weakness and in fear and much trembling," 1 Corinthians 2:3

v5 Paul was encouraged, reinvigorated.

v6

Paul was so thoroughly worn out, gripped by fear, and deeply discouraged that he was about to quit.

"Do not be afraid, but go on speaking and do not be silent" v9

"for I am with you, and no one will attack you to harm you," v10

We are often attacked, but we survive.

The tender intervention of our loving Lord when we are discouraged, downtrodden, or despondent.

Isaiah 40:1, 10-11

"Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the Lord!" Psalm 27:14

Psalm 31:24

My soul waits in silence for God alone.

Was Paul a naïve optimist? No. He understood God's sovereignty.

God's absolute sovereignty in salvation

"before the ages began" or, "before times eternal" (ESV optional trans.).

That means, that God alone chose, out of a spiritually dead humanity, a people to make alive for Himself before He even created time.
