⁸ Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: ¹⁰ But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

¹² Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

¹⁵ Thou shalt not steal.

QUESTION # 98: WHERE IS THE MORAL LAW SUMMARILY COMPREHENDED?

ANSWER:

THE MORAL LAW IS SUMMARILY COMPREHENDED IN THE TEN COMMANDMENTS, WHICH WERE DELIVERED BY THE VOICE OF GOD UPON MOUNT SINAI, AND WRITTEN BY HIM IN TWO TABLES OF STONE;^A AND ARE RECORDED IN THE TWENTIETH CHAPTER OF EXODUS. THE FOUR FIRST COMMANDMENTS CONTAINING OUR DUTY TO GOD, AND THE OTHER SIX OUR DUTY TO MAN.^B
