ACTS 8: 1 - 25

1. Great outward appearances

Simon, a sinner with form (Vs 9 - 11)

⁹ But there was a certain man called Simon, who previously practiced **sorcery** in the city and **astonished** the people of Samaria, claiming that he was someone great, ¹⁰ to whom they all gave heed, from the least to the greatest, saying, "This man is the great power of God." ¹¹ And they **heeded him** because he had astonished them with his sorceries for a long time.

Simon, a sinner who hears and responds outwardly (Vs 12 - 13)

¹² But when **they believed** Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women **were baptized**. ¹³ Then Simon himself **also believed**; and when he **was baptized** he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the miracles and signs which were done.

2. Sinful passions fed and indulged

Sin begins in our desires (Vs 18 - 19)

¹⁸ And when Simon **saw** that through the laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Spirit was given, he offered them money, ¹⁹ saying, "**Give me** this power also, that anyone on whom I lay hands may receive the Holy Spirit."

- Our desires shape our thoughts (Vs 20)
 - ²⁰ But Peter said to him, "Your money perish with you, because you **thought** that the gift of God could be purchased with money!
- What we do outwardly shows what we're like inwardly

3. The kind of 'faith' that cannot save you

- Outward actions and ceremonies don't get you right with God (Vs 21)
 - ²¹ You have neither part nor portion in this matter, for your heart is not right in the sight of God.
- Simon thought that he was a Christian (Vs 21)
- Faith without repentance is no faith at all
 - ²² **Repent** therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.
 - ²³ For I see that **you are poisoned** by bitterness and bound by iniquity."
