INTRODUCTION

- 1. The church in Thessalonica preserved & persevering: diligent dependence.
- 2. 2 Thes 3:3-5.

1st: The Place of Supplication - 2:16-3:2

- 1. Context: prayer 2:16-17.
- 2. 3:1-2 Paul solicits prayer
- 3. 3:3-5 confident that Lord will answer prayers

2nd: A People Sustained

- 1. But the Lord is faithful: But = contrast w/ v2. Faithless & fruitless. Pain of broken promises [Pr 20:6; 25:19]. Lord is faithful 1Th 5:24. Comfort
- 2. He will strengthen you = 2:16-17. Strengthen: support, sustain in context of threats. <u>2Th 2</u> re: Apostasy & Antichrist <u>v9-15</u>. [Eph 3:16].
- 3. He will protect you from the evil one: military: defend from attack. Evil => Satan [2Th 2]. Rev: persecution & seduction - Jude 1:24-25
- 4. We have confidence [persuaded] in Lord concerning you. Again, the Lord is faithful. Concerning you: see Lord's grace in each other.
 - i. Barnabas -> Antioch witnessed the grace of God [A 11:23]
 - ii. 2C 5:16-18a God's chosen nobodies [1C 1:26-28; 2C 12:11].
 - iii. But God gives life to dead [R 4:17]; we are children of God [1 Jn 3:2]
 - iv. Now, define yourself according to God's grace.

3rd: A People Striving

- 1. <u>2 Th 3:4b</u> you are doing & will continue to do: present & future obedience. Do what? 2:16,17 good work & word
- 2. what we command 1Th 4:1-2; 2 Th 3:6 [1Th 5:14]

4th: A People Sustained

- 1. 2Th 3:5 May the Lord: [v1,3,4,5,6]
- 2. direct: lead the way & remove obstacles to reach destiny
- 3. *your hearts:* 2:17 focuses on heart. Jn Eadie: "Self-led hearts are usually misled hearts." [Pro 4:23; Lk 21:34-36]
- 4. Lord sustains us AS HS guides & directs our hearts.

5th: A People Sustained & Striving: into the love of God & the steadfastness of X.

- 1. *into the love of God:* God's love for us or our love for God? [1 Jn 4:19; Jn 14:21]. In "last days" experience being loved & love.
- 2. the steadfastness of Christ: Christ's steadfastness or our Christ-like steadfastness? [Phil 2:5-8; Jn 14:2-3].

Applic #1: We Are Sustained in Grace AS We Strive by Grace

- 1. What does God's sustaining grace look like? 1C 15:10
 - i. inclusio: the grace of God. What do we see? "I" 4x & "me" 2x. Paul.
 - ii. See who he is: I am what I am. Popeye: feed heart the "spinach" of Word. Descartes: I believe therefore I'm regenerated.
 - iii. I labored [Eng: copious]. Labor = evidence of grace
