

## **AM WORKSHEET**

**Title:** Difficult Circumstances, Destructive People, Pt 1 **Text:** Exodus 17:1-16

**Key Thought:** Even when we are pressed to our physical limits, *if we belong to the Lord*, we have no right to question whether He *loves* us or not. His love for His people is *everlasting!* Let's remember Him & be encouraged!

### **1A THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL SET OUT FOR THE MOUNTAIN OF GOD, vv1-3**

**1B** After an arduous travel stage, Israel **CAMPED** in Rephidim, **v1**.

**2B** The Israelites **CONTENDED** w/Moses because there was no water to drink, **v2**.

**3B** They **COMPLAINED** against Moses & **CLAIMED** he brought them there to kill them, **v3**.

### **2A MOSES CRIED OUT FOR THE MERCY OF GOD, vv4-7**

**1B** He was **CONCERNED** about losing his life at the hands of some in the congregation, **v4**.

**2B** He was **COMMANDED** to strike a Rock IN HOREB w/the rod of God to give water to the people, **vv5, 6**.

**3B** He **CALLED** the place Tempted (*Massah*) & Contention (*Meribah*), **v7**.
